Men's and Women's épée:

26-27-28 May 2017

The Colombian fencing federation invites fencing family across the world to our Grand Prix Epee tournament, which will be held in Bogota, Colombia on *26-27-28 May 2017*.

Bogota is the capital of Colombia. The population is about 8 million inhabitants.



The city lies at 2600 meters altitude on a mountain plateau in the eastern mountains of the Andes. The city is the Capital District of Colombia. While Bogota is almost on the equator, the average daily temperature oscillates between 18 degrees and 9 degrees.

14:00-20:00 Weapon control women’s epee, payment of entry fee

08:30 : Poules, preliminary table

20:30: End of preliminary tour, list of 64 male fencers for main table

Saturday - May 27th – Women’s epee:

08:00-10:00: payment of entry fee Weapon control women’s epee

09:00 Poules, preliminary table

18:00: End of preliminary tour, list of 64 female fencers for main table

Sunday - March 28th – Men’s and women’s epee (T64 and finals):

08:00 Tableau 64 men

10:00 Tableau 64 women

18:00 Finals (Women’s Semifinals, Men’s Semifinals, Women’s Final, Men’s Final)

20:30 Award Ceremony

Participation

Each national federation may enter a maximum of 12 fencers.

Open to all fencers with valid 2016/2017 FIE License. No fencer is allowed to take part in an official event of the FIE unless he or she is at least 13 years old on 1 January in the year of the competition. Entries of fencers, teams and referees can only be made at the FIE website, www.fie.org, respecting the deadlines specified in the FIE Rules (cf. o.54).

Entry fee Individual competition: EUR 100. Or its equivalent in USD at the Exchange rate provided by the Bogota GP organization on the day of event



Referees

All Referees are designated by the FIE.

Formula

One qualifying round of poules, a preliminary direct elimination table, a main direct elimination table of 64 fencers to qualify for a final by direct elimination

Doping

Doping control will be enhanced according to FIE rules, and WADA protocol. COLDEPORTES (national institute of sports) will be in charge
