10:00 Start of the 1. round of pools (pre-tournament)
12:00 Start of the 2. round of pools (pools of the satellite competition)
14:00 Start of the DE
17:30 Start of the semi-finals and final

Participation: Participation is not limited.

Entry: Open to all fencers with valid 2018-2019 FIE License.

No fencer can take part in an official event of the FIE unless he or she is at least 13 years old on 1 January in the year of the competition. Entries of fencers and referees can only be made at the FIE website, www.fie.org, respecting the deadlines specified in the FIE Rules (cf. o.54).

Entry fee: EUR 30,- (NOK 300.-).

The entry fee is paid for each national delegation by bank transfer to: Bygdø Fekteklubb (Bygdø Fencing Club), IBAN: NO09 7001 0519 185, no later than September 21st.

The entry fee can also be paid at the registration with deadline 09:30.

Prizes:

1. Place: 1 000 EUR
 2. Place: 500 EUR
 3. Places. 200 EUR
- Places 5-8: 100 EUR

Referee obligation: Each nation having more than four fencers must provide at least one referee.

Weapon control: Masks (only with new fastening system) and gloves will be checked.

Formula:

The Oslo Cup World Cup Satellite competition will use the FIE formula for junior competitions, but there will be organized a pre-tournament (1. round of pools) in which all the participants in the satellite tournament take part. The pools in the satellite competition (2. round of pools) will be based on the results of the pre-tournament.
