This moral report covers the events which occurred over the period from 1st January to 31 December 2015.

## OBITUARY

The International Fencing Federation has been affected by the death of several friends:

### JOÃO MARTINS (POR), 1926-2015

The President of the General Assembly of the Portuguese Fencing Federation, Mr. Joao Martins, died on 9 March 2015, at the age of 89. Mr. Martins played a very important part in the life of the Portuguese Fencing Federation, being the General Secretary during Chito Rodrigues and Jose Valarinho's presidencies. Despite never being a fencer himself he was husband, father and grandfather of fencers and father-in-law of Joao Pedro Vinha, one of the most important Portuguese maître d'armes of the 20th century.

Joao Martins started working for fencing in the 1960s as a director in one of Portugal's most important sports clubs of the time, Atheneu Comercial de Lisboa. Under his leadership, its fencing section soon became very powerful. Atheneu hired one of the most competent Portuguese coaches in Herculano Pimentel and developed an entire generation of talented fencers.

Joao Martins' organisational capacities were quickly recognised by the Portuguese Fencing Federation. When elected President in 1980, one of Chito Rodrigues' first decisions was to invite Martins to be his General Secretary, a role he played brilliantly until 2000, first with Rodrigues and then with Jose Valarinho. After that, he was vice-president of the General Assembly and became president of the General Assembly in 2006, after Frederico Valarinho's election. Joao Martins was emotionally close to our sport until his last breath. His wife, Margarida, started fencing at the age of 45, both his children, Maria Joao and Jaime were fencers, and his grandson Jaime was a talented epeeist.

To evaluate how important Joao Martins was for the Portuguese Fencing and how important fencing was in his life, one of his last sentences, after being asked by his daughter to sign the convocation for the General Assembly which took place at the end of March was: "If I don't go, you will, but the General Assembly must take place".

### ANÍBAL ILLUECA HERRANDO (PAN), MH, 1946-2015

He was a FIE Member of Honour, named by the Congress in 2008, and Member of the FIE Hall of Fame.

Anibal Illueca Herrando was born on April 29, 1946 in the city of Panama, Republic of Panama. He is a lawyer who studied at the Universidad Javeriana de Bogotá, Colombia, where he was granted his diploma of Law in Economics in 1964. He then obtained his degree in Law and Political Science from the National University of Panama in 1970 and in Private Law from the University of Nice, France in 1977.

He held important positions as Assistant to the President of the Republic of Panama, Legal Advisor to the National Bank of Panama, and Alternate Magistrate in the Supreme Court of Panama. He was a founding partner of Illueca and Associates Law Office.

He added to his professional career the practice of the sport fencing. He was a member of the fencing Olympic team from Panama in 1968, then becoming an international referee in 1972.

He also had a career in sports administration, in particular with FIE as a member of the Disciplinary Commission from 2000 to 2008. He was President of the Pan-American Fencing Confederation from 1999 to 2008, Vice-president and President of the Panama Fencing Federation from 1992 to 2012.

### MARIO FAVIA (ITA), MH, 1930-2015

Mario Favia was a former Italian foilist born in Alexandria, Egypt, on January 6th 1930.

He was nominated Member of Honour by the 2001 Congress and Vice-President of Honour in 2007.

He worked as an architect for over 50 years (1958-2010) and, at the same time, had a career in sports administration. In the FIE, he was elected member of the Rules Commission from 1993 to 1996.

Then he was elected member of the Executive Committee from 1996 to 2004 and nominated Secretary General from 1996 to 2000 and from 2000 to 2004.

He also was Member of Honour of the Italian Fencing Federation.

As an athlete, he was member of the Italian foil team from 1952 to 1960. He was twice World Champion under 21 at foil in 1950 and 1951.

He won two gold medals in individual and team at the 1953 Universiade; three gold medals in individual and team foil and in team epee at the 1955 Universiade. He won the International Individual Foil Tournament in 1954 and 1958.

Mario Favia also was an international referee, category A (foil and epee) and B (sabre) and was a member of the Directoire Technique for various World Championships and Olympic Games from 1960 to 1996.

### **DR. EMILIO ECHEVERRI DE LA ROCHE (COL), 1929-2015**

For many years, he was the president of the Colombian Fencing Federation, a member of the Executive Committee of the Colombian Olympic Committee, a member of the FIE Medical Commission, and FIE Medical Commission delegate at the 1992 Barcelona Olympic Games.

Emilio Echeverri de la Roche was a pioneer of Colombian fencing, and winner of numerous medals in the 50s and 60s.

His career began in multi-sport competitions at the 1st Pan American Games held in 1951. He later joined the Colombian national team at the 3rd Bolivarian Games, where Colombia took the silver in team épée. At the 7th Central American and Caribbean Games he won the bronze in team épée.

He participated in the 2nd Pan American Games in 1955, then in the Olympics in 1956, where he also saw victory in épée. He also competed in the 8th Central American and Caribbean Games, where he won the silver at foil in individual and team.

In 1960, Emilio Echeverri returned to the Olympics in Rome. A year later, in Barranquilla, he took two silver medals in team foil and team épée.

After his participation in his last event, at the 8th Central American and Caribbean Games in 1962, Emilio Echeverri became a national icon, thanks to the two gold medals he took home in individual and team foil.

### **SERGEY ALEKSANDROVICH SHARIKOV (RUS) 1974-2015**

Born on 18 June 1974 in Moscow, he was a world, Olympic, European and Universiades champion.

Sergey Sharikov graduated from the Russian State University of Physical education and Diplomatic Academy. He participated for MGFSO and Dynamo (Moscow). His first coach was A. Filatov. Then he trained with V. Puchkov.

He was honoured Master of sport.

Sergey Sharikov had very impressive records :

He was Olympic champion by team in the Olympic Games in Atlanta (1996) and in Sydney (2000). Silver medallist in individual in the Olympic Games in Atlanta (1996) and bronze medallist by team in the Olympic Games in Athens (2004).

He was World champion by team in 2001, 2002, 2003. Silver medallist at the World championships in 1995 and 1997 in team events. Bronze medallist at the 1998 World Championships in individual and team events.

He was European Champion in individual in 2000 and in team events in 2000, 2001, 2002 and 2004. Silver medallist in the 2002 European championships in individual. Bronze medallist in the 2004 European championships in individual and by team in the 1998 European championships.

He was gold medallist in the 2001 Universiade in individual and by team in 1995 and 2001. Bronze medallist in the 1997 and 1999 Universiades in individual and by team in 1999.

He won the Russian championships in 1997, 2003 and 2004.

From 2008, he worked as the head of the fencing Russian national junior team.

### **ILDIKO TORDASI (HUN) 1951-2015**

Ildikó Tordasi was gold medalist of the 1976 Montreal Olympic Games in individual women's foil.

As an athlete of the Club MTK, pupil of master Bertalan Szcs she has earned 15 Olympic and World Championship medals during her sports career.

After the unforgettable Ilona Elek another one of the three Hungarian women's foil individual Olympic Champions has passed away.

Her Olympic victory in Montreal certainly remains an everlasting memory for the lovers of our sport, however she won another 14 Olympic and World Championship medals, including a World Championship gold medal in women's foil team.

She was a top athlete of our beloved sport, one of the most successful Hungarian women's foil fencers.

She has always been fencing for her club MTK, and after her fencing career she has been a coach there for decades.

### **SH RAJENDRA SINGH RANA (IND), 1960-2015**

He was the Secretary General of Fencing Association of India (FAI).

Born on 1st January 1960, he was a prominent boxer for his state and participated in many National Championships during his student life.

He had been a Minister of State in the Government of Uttar Pradesh in Lucknow, India and was associated with the state Olympic Association & state Fencing Association for many years

His death is a great setback for the FAI and also many other sports organisations, because he was always ready to serve athletes.

## FRANTIŠEK JANDA (CZE), 1967-2015.

František Janda was born on July 5, 1967 in Prague. He was a film producer, and General Manager of film and TV Company S PRO ALFA FILM CZECH REPUBLIC.

His original profession was a professional soldier. He studied psychology, majoring in special army preparation. In 1990 – 1991 he participated in combat operations Desert Shield and Desert Storm.

He was the holder of the Saudi Arabian Battle Order, the Kuwait Liberation Medal, Cross of Merit of the Czech Army and other honours.

In 2005, he resigned from the position of General Manager of S PRO ALFA FILM CZECH REPUBLIC and decided to devote his life to sport and fencing.

His fencing career was impressive:

1994	Executive Vice-President of the Czech Fencing Federation
1995 – 2010	President of the Czech Fencing Federation
1995 – 2012	Member of the FIE PR and Promotion Commission
1998 – 2012	President of the FIE PR and Promotion Commission
2000 – 2005	FIE International referee at epee and foil
2004	Participation at the Olympic Games in Athens as a referee in fencing events of Modern Pentathlon
2009	Member of the Executive Committee of the Czech Olympic Committee
2009	President of the European Fencing Confederation (EFC) and thus member of the FIE Executive Committee
2013	Re-elected President of the European Fencing Confederation (EFC) for a further four-year term.

Frantisek Janda was 48 years old. The FIE and the sport of fencing have lost a remarkable leader, a talented fencer and a referee of great merit. But above all, the FIE has lost a great friend who was appreciated and respected by all. František Janda passed away on the way to fuel the sport that he loved and to which he dedicated a large part of his life.

## DR. CSABA FENYVESI (HUN), 1943-2015

Csaba Fenyvesi was born on April 14, 1943. As an epee fencer, he was three-time Olympic champion and three-time world champion.

He was Olympic champion in 1972 in the Olympic Games of Munich, in both individual and team events and Olympic champion in 1968, in the Olympic Games of Mexico City, in the team event.

In the World Championships Csaba Fenyvesi won:

- three gold medals by team in 1970, 1971 and 1978
- two silver medals by team in 1969 and 1973
- one bronze medal in individual in 1970
- two bronze medals by team in 1967 and 1975

After his fencing career, Csaba Fenyvesi started to work as a plastic surgeon, and from 1972 he was a cancer researcher surgeon and clinical adjunct.

He was a guest researcher at the US-based United Virginia Cancer Research Institute, and he achieved significant results in tumour surgery. In 1994 he became managing doctor of an American foundation's cancer research institute.

He was manager of the fencing section of BVSC sport club in Budapest for many years, and was a member of the executive board of the Hungarian Fencing Federation.

## 1.4 ANTI-DOPING

### 1.4.1 CONTROLS

The fight against doping was maintained throughout the period and no case of doping occurred in competitions run by the FIE.

- 419 tests were performed in competitions and 31 tests were conducted outside competitions.
- 317 tests during competitions and 6 tests outside of competition were performed by national anti-doping agencies using the ADAMS system (Anti-Doping Administration & Management System).

### 1.4.2 ANTI-DOPING EDUCATION

This year's highly successful anti-doping outreach program was conducted from 4 to 7 April 2015 during the Junior and Cadet World Fencing Championships in Tashkent.

It provided another excellent opportunity to inform and educate young fencers from many countries.

The event owes its success largely to the friendly and efficient cooperation and support provided the Uzbekistan Fencing Federation's, the local Organising Committee, and the three enthusiastic student volunteers who helped us overcome the local language challenges.



Following our well tried and tested formula, many young fencers (as well as coaches) played the computer-based WADA “Play True” Quiz game which forms the backbone of this educational event.

The FIE once again made available substantial cash prizes for the winners of the daily “Lucky Draw” competition.

Fencers and coaches who played the educational Quiz game were also given the popular free “USB” wrist-bands which contained copies of the Quiz game, anti-doping videos and a wealth of informative documentation which they were strongly encouraged to share with the wider fencing community on their return home.

Fencers from 61 countries, as well as a number of coaches and officials participated in the Quiz and took the opportunity of discussing doping issues with the anti-doping personnel.

They were expressly encouraged to copy and share the information with their fellow fencers, coaches and officials on their return home, thereby helping to spread the anti-doping message world-wide.

Altogether a record number of 528 participants (483 fencers, 36 coaches, 9 officials) took part in this successful Outreach programme.

We anticipate holding a similar anti-doping Outreach project during the 2016 Junior and Cadet World Fencing Championships.

## 1.5 INTERNET SITES, SOCIAL MEDIA, MAGAZINES

### FIE MEDIA REPORT 2015

Over the course of 2015, the FIE developed its digital communication platforms and increased its online audience at a significant rate.

The FIE has a strong presence in social media and recently launched a new website, which continues to evolve to embrace new technologies and adapt to our needs. We have added the digital magazine ESCRIME XXI, which keeps fans up to date on our news. Those are the main pillars of FIE digital communication, which are developing digital fencing and that connect the sport with a broader audience than ever.

### SOCIAL MEDIA

The FIE media team developed a dynamic social media strategy through 2015, following IOC recommendations and existing platforms. With two new platforms (Instagram and Google +), along with Facebook, Twitter and YouTube, the FIE now runs five social media platforms on a daily basis. Online views on the YouTube Fencing channel have reached 10 million, from 7.5 million in 2014. During 2015, with the Fencing Grand Prix and the World Championships in Moscow, the FIE was able to double the engagement rate of followers on Facebook, Twitter and Instagram. Additionally, with the cooperation of Chinese fencing, FIE runs Chinese social media platforms (Weibo, Youku).

## FENCING DIGITAL MAGAZINE - ESCRIME XXI



In 2012, ESCRIME XXI became the first interactive digital magazine in five languages of any International Federation. In 2015 the digital magazine reached 500,000 page views, which is a 66% increase from 2014. The reason for such a large increase is the content variation from fencing stories around the world, as well as the efficient cross-communication on social media and national federations' platforms. The most popular territories are Russia, France, Mexico, Egypt and Taiwan. The magazine reaches out to a large population globally and increases fencing awareness, spreading a positive image for our sport.

## NEW FIE WEBSITE FIE.ORG

At the beginning of 2015, the FIE launched its new website, merging the previous two sites into one in order to boost visits and maintain a consistent image. The website combines administration services for all national federations as well as press services. For the first time, at the FIE website viewers can watch competitions, highlights and photo galleries dedicated to specific events. Over the last year the new website received 1,096,000 page views, with the most popular territories being USA, France, Italy, Russia and Germany.

## TV FACTS AND FIGURES\* FOR THE FENCING WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS IN MOSCOW 2015

The event was covered in 12 territories with an overall broadcast time of 270 hours, 57 minutes 39 seconds. A total cumulative viewership of 248.59 million was reached through the coverage of this event. Furthermore, the event gained a total of 2.39 million event impressions, of which 64% were derived from specific coverage (live, delayed and highlights), whereas 36% were generated through secondary coverage (news and magazines). The home market, Russia, covered more than 14 hours of broadcast time and had a cumulated viewership of more than 62 million people. The country with the highest cumulative audience and media impact was China. China reached 63.57 million viewers, totalling 945 million event impressions.

## 3. FIE ASSISTANCE WITH SPORTS DEVELOPMENT

### 3.1. ATHLETE TRAINING COURSES

Two courses were held over the period, with the FIE paying all expenses for these (air ticket, local transport, hotel, food, experts).

The FIE continued to pay for the athletes from the end of this course up until the individual competitions for the World Championships were completed.

These courses were organised in order to target the following points:

- Encouraging and facilitating the participation of all the national federations in the World Championships.
- Offering a week of intensive preparation to fencers who do not always have enough training partners to allow them to aim for a high international level.
- Introducing these young fencers with definite talent to the entire content and structure of a modern training session.
- Allowing them to benefit from advice from highly experienced fencing teachers, with the determination to implement this advice in practice.
- Providing them with their initial contact with the world fencing elite under the best possible conditions in order to stimulate them to redouble their efforts, giving them the encouragement to provide an example when they return to their training halls.

#### **a) Tashkent (UZB), during the World Championships - juniors/cadets 2015:**

The course involved foil (6 athletes) as well as épée (13 athletes).

Athletes from 19 countries took part, comprising 4 from Europe, 5 from Africa, 5 from America and 5 from Asia.

The following fencing teachers were appointed: Kuki Petru (ROU) for foil and Alexander Gorbachuk (UKR) for épée.

#### **b) Moscow (RUS), during the World Championships - seniors 2015:**

Athletes from 41 countries took part in this course involving all three weapons, comprising: 6 from Europe, 8 from Africa, 15 from America, 11 from Asia and 1 from Oceania.

Per weapon these numbers involved: 13 athletes with the foil, 20 athletes with the épée and 8 athletes with the sabre.

The following fencing teachers were appointed: Kuki Petru (ROU) for the foil, Zidaru Octavian (ROU) for the épée, and Tychler Gennady (RSA) for the sabre.

### 3.2. DAKAR SCHOOL

The FIE continues to provide its support to the African federations by training African fencers at the Dakar Fencing School as part of its fencing development programme in Africa.

The school was set up in 1999. By the end of 2016, seventeen years since it was established, the African federations will have one hundred and twenty-eight (128) specialists capable of running a programme for promoting fencing.

We should point out that the trainees have become more effective now that the conditions for their stay have been improved. This relates in particular to the students' journey from the accommodation centre to the stadium where their practical and theory classes are held, as this is now only a five-minute walk away.

## COMPOSITION OF THE 10TH EIMA (ECOLE INTERNATIONALE MAITRES D'ARMES - INTERNATIONAL FENCING SCHOOL, DAKAR) CAMPAIGN.

The purpose of moving from the former accommodation centre to a new building which is nearer was to take up to twenty (20) trainees, given the considerable demand in previous years, and reduce the distance between the school and the centre.

### THE ACCOMMODATION CENTRE

The accommodation Centre consists of a building on 3 floors with over 10 bedrooms and capable of housing up to twenty (20) students. Students are allocated single or double accommodation depending on the size of the room. Professional catering is provided in situ.

Trainees receive an allowance at the start of each month for breakfast and dinner and are responsible for organising themselves and ensuring that they eat properly and arrive at their lessons on time.

### RECRUITMENT CONDITIONS

Students are recruited by means of sending out a call for applications involving clearly defined conditions. These forms are sent to all the affiliated African federations with a copy forwarded to the FIE. Federations which have never sent any candidates or who have fewer candidates than the others take priority.

### THE PROGRAMME :

Fencing topics are taught from 7h30 am to 12h30 and from 14h30 to 17h.

### THE INFRASTRUCTURES

Since 2013, the EIMA has benefited from the availability of an armory within the national stadium. This has allowed the teaching staff and the students to have more independence, with no restrictions on organising their working hours. Converting the area involved:

- Renovating and providing equipment for the armory in terms of strips, mats and mirrors
- Renovating and equipping the staff room (cupboards, air-conditioning units, desks and armchairs).
- Renovating and equipping the classroom (storage cabinets, individual tables, chairs, air conditioning units, etc.)

As in previous years, teachers and trainees received their equipment packages (weapons and clothing) from the FIE. In addition to this free equipment, pupils receive an allowance from the FIE on starting and completing training and this constitutes their pocket money.

- Contracted staff who basically consist of staff teaching complementary subjects.

In addition to this permanent staff, FIE experts comprising the chief executive and her assistant, as well as the Sports director and his deputy, carried out visits in September and October 2015, to verify the accommodation conditions and teaching methods, suggesting corrective action if necessary.

These various visits meant that all the problems could be identified and corrective action is under way.

## FINAL EXAMINATION

The trainees finished their training with an examination on completion. The panel, consisting of the coaches, was chaired by Madame Ao JIE, deputy Sports director of the FIE.

The trainees were assessed as students and as fencing teachers. At the end of the examinations, all the trainees passed and were declared to be fit to develop conditions for practising the discipline in their country.

## 3.3 OFMA - OCEANIA FENCING MASTER'S ACADEMY

### ATTENDANCE AT FIE COACH TRAINING COURSES

In the 2015 financial year, there were no opportunities for coaches from Oceania to attend any FIE Coaching Courses. The OFC hopes that there will be future opportunities to attend FIE courses as they are an important opportunity for the ongoing professional development of Oceania coaches and are greatly appreciated.

### 3.6 PRIZES FOR WINNERS OF THE WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS

Following a private initiative started by the President of the FIE in 2009, prizes are awarded to winning athletes in the World Championships. These prize money was extended in 2015 to the World Championships - juniors and cadets in Tashkent and the World Championships - seniors 2015 in Moscow (RUS).

**The total amount of prize money paid out in 2015 was: 1,581,600 USD.**

#### 3.6.1 WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS - JUNIORS AND CADETS IN TASHKENT

##### a) Cadets

The medallists for each weapon received a voucher for equipment from the FIE partner Allstar/Uhlmann:

- Fencer in 1st place, in each of the 6 weapons: voucher of 2,000 USD  
5,000 USD were paid to the athlete's Federation to cover the athlete's training and travel costs.
- Fencer in 2nd place, in each of the 6 cadet weapons: voucher of 2,000 USD  
3,000 USD were paid to the athlete's Federation to cover the athlete's training and travel costs.
- Fencers in 3rd place, in each of the 6 junior and cadet weapons: voucher of 2,000 USD  
1,000 USD were paid to the athlete's Federation to cover the athlete's training and travel costs.

**The total amount of this prize money was 108,000 USD.**

### **b) Cadet mixed team event**

- For the team classified as coming in first position, amounts were distributed as follows:
  - An equipment voucher for each of the 6 athletes, for an amount of 2,000 USD, from the FIE partner Allstar/Uhlmann.
  - 8,400 USD were paid to the athletes' Federation to cover training and travel costs for the six athletes in the team.
- For the team classified as coming in second position, amounts were distributed as follows:
  - An equipment voucher for each of the 6 athletes, for an amount of 2,000 USD, from the FIE partner Allstar/Uhlmann.
  - 3,000 USD were paid to the athletes' Federation to cover training and travel costs for the six athletes in the team.
- For each of the members of the team classified in third position:
  - An equipment voucher for each of the 6 athletes, for an amount of 1,700 USD, from the FIE partner Allstar/Uhlmann.

**The total amount of this prize money was 45,600 USD.**

### **c) Juniors**

The medallists received:

- In individual, for each of the 6 weapons:
  - Fencer in 1st position, 7,000 USD
  - Fencer in 2nd position, 5,000 USD
  - Fencers in 3rd position, 3,000 USD
- Junior teams, for each of the 6 weapons:
  - Team in 1st position, 20,000 USD
  - Team in 2nd position, 15,000 USD
  - Team in 3rd position, 10,000 USD

**The total amount of this prize money was 378,000 USD**

## **3.6.2 WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS - SENIORS - IN MOSCOW**

The medallists received:

  - Fencer in 1st position, 30,000 USD
  - Fencer in 2nd position, 20,000 USD

  - Team in 2nd position, 30,000 USD
  - Team in 3rd position, 25,000 USD

The total amount of this prize money was 1,050,000 USD

## **3.7 ASSISTANCE FOR ATHLETE PARTICIPATION**

Since 2009, the FIE has been implementing a special programme providing assistance to NF athletes taking part in the senior regional championships and the World Championships (Juniors and Seniors).

For each national federation taking part, all the confederations received a grant to cover the costs (air ticket and hotel expenses) of an athlete taking part in the:

- World championships - juniors and cadets 2015
- World championships - seniors 2015
- Continental championships - seniors 2015

### 3.8 ASSISTANCE FOR THE PARTICIPATION OF PRESIDENTS

As a result of the grant programme (air ticket, hotel and meal expenses) applicable to all the presidents of Federations, they were able to be involved in the work carried out by the FIE Congress 2015, which is very important for the development of fencing throughout the world. 111 national federations took part in the FIE Congress in Guangzhou.

### 3.9 ASSISTANCE FOR CONFEDERATIONS

All the confederations received an annual grant for their administrative expenses.

### 3.10 ASSISTANCE FOR COMPETITION ORGANISERS

Each national federation organising an FIE competition (senior World Cup, Grand Prix) and making the relevant request received a grant of 3000 euros to cover the costs of video-refereeing.

### 3.11 VETERAN FUND

The Fund specialising in assistance for fencing veterans, the "VSE", was set up by the Foundation entitled "For the future of fencing" at the end of 2012.

The operational priorities of the VSE were defined as follows:

- to give fencing veterans access to medical services (co-financing of costly treatments, surgical procedures, medicines, etc.);
- to give fencing veterans access to sickness insurance;
- to support fencing veterans in difficult situations (e.g. to resolve practical problems: house repairs, car repairs, etc.);
- to finance programmes and events to provide social support for fencing veterans.

The criteria used to define the recipients of the fund are as follows:

- Fencing veterans - people with close relations with the fencing community /the world of fencing (1), acknowledged at national and international level (2), and falling into one of the applicable age groups;
- On request of the VSE, each applicant must provide all the supporting documentation required to check the request and safeguard transfer of the gift in accordance with Russian legislation

1. Career as a competitor and (or) coach, or other significant contribution to developing fencing or making it popular.
2. Personal results and accomplishments; results of pupils; projects carried out and accomplishments within the para-sporting field; acknowledgement of merits or services rendered to fencing.

The total amount for assistance requests made to the VSE in 2015 was approximately 100,000 USD, of which 80,710 USD (24,540 USD, 52,250 EUR) were allocated to direct assistance for fencing veterans all over the world, making a request either directly or through their respective national federations.

### 3.12 «CLUB MOVEMENT INITIATIVE»

The Club Movement Initiative (CMI) was launched in 2014 with the aim of “creating an international network of major fencing sites and establishing a system to develop their assets in terms of talent”.

After approving the business plan:

- 1) We identified several clubs
- 2) We established formal relations with them by signing agreements which also committed their respective national federations
- 3) We launched the project in the third quarter of 2014.

The CMI network currently has 9 sites in 8 countries. Our partners are:

1. Tauberbischofsheim Fencing Club, Germany;
2. Fencers Club New York, United States;
3. Cercle d’Escrime Melun, France;
4. Novosibirsk Regional Fencing, Russia;
5. Smolensk Academy of Sport and Physical Culture, Russia;
6. Scherma Modica, Italy;
7. Vasas Sport Club, Hungary;
8. Laoshan Youth Fencing Training Center, China;
9. National Training Center, Japan.

We welcomed 58 coaches from Europe, Africa, Asia and the Americas as part of the training for coaches organised jointly by the FIE and our partner clubs.

## **Auditors' report on the limited audit**

In our capacity as statutory auditors, we have audited the annual accounts (balance sheet, income statement and notes to the accounts) of the International Fencing Federation for the year ended 31 December 2015.

Responsibility for the preparation of the annual accounts falls to the management, while our task consists of auditing those accounts. We declare that we meet the legal requirements for approval and independence.

Our audit was performed in accordance with the Swiss rules on limited audits. These rules require the audit to be planned and carried out in such a way that any significant irregularities in the annual accounts can be identified. A limited audit chiefly covers hearings, analytical checks and appropriate detailed verifications of the available documents in the audited company. However, verifications of operating cash flows and the internal control system, as well as hearings and other audit operations intended to detect fraud or other violations of the law, do not form part of this audit.

During our audit, we did not discover any element that might lead us to conclude that the annual accounts are not in accordance with the law (Arts. 957 et seq. of the Code of Obligations) and the Statutes.

**1. Accounting principles applied and not statutory:**

- 1.1. The Fédération Internationale d'Escrime (referred to hereafter as the "FIE") is an international, non-governmental, non-profit organisation, taking the legal form of a Swiss association with its registered offices in Lausanne, Switzerland.

It is recognized by the International Olympic Committee (IOC) as leading world authority in fencing. The FIE imposes rules governing the organisation of international competitions and supervises their application.

- 1.2. Financial statements are submitted in Swiss francs (CHF) in accordance with accounting standards governed by the Code des obligations Suisse (*Swiss Code of Obligations*), the regulations and articles of association of the FIE and the accounting methods indicated below.

These annual accounts constitute the first application of the new accounting law.

1.3. *Entries in foreign currency*

Transactions in foreign currency were converted into Swiss francs (CHF) at the exchange rate applicable at the time they are carried out. Monetary assets and liabilities in foreign currencies were converted at the rate of exchange applicable on the balance sheet date.

The rates applicable to the balance below correspond to the closing rates as at 31 December 2015.

1.4. *Federations and other short-term receivables*

The receivables from the Federations as well as the other short-term receivables were entered in the accounts at their nominal value. Individual value adjustments were carried out, with the residual balance being the subject of a flat-rate value adjustment of 5 %.

1.5. *Inventory*

The inventory is evaluated at the acquisition cost or cost price. The acquisition cost and the cost price of the inventory is determined according to the weighted average cost method.

1.6. *Non-current tangible assets*

Non-current tangible assets are recorded in the balance sheet at their historic cost, after deducting the accumulated depreciation. Depreciation is carried out according to the linear method. Any immediate depreciation is carried out within the framework of fiscally acceptable limits on decision of the Treasurer.

Depreciation rates are fixed according to the estimated duration of use:
