ANNUAL INTER-SCHOOL COMPETITION

The 5th David's cup was held on the 24th of November at Children's International School, Lekki.

For the first time we had both male & female in foil and epee for U17, U14 and U10 (mixed). We ran a total of 9 competitions. We also featured for the first time 10 government schools from 5 LGAs

Opasanya Kibati won Gold for the U10 mixed foil event with Zakia Maria winning silver, Asemora Seth and Sawari Tully-Jo came third to win bronze.

In the U14 Men's foil event, Ashaolu Tofunmi won Gold, Martins Bade won Silver, with Gordon Everett-Roger and Omar Mohammed in joint third position.





Adekunle Oreoluwa won the U14 male Epee event defeating Awodun Nifemi.

Firidat Olufowobi won Gold for the U14 Female Epee event, edging out Odesanya Ebunrere in the final, Rasheed Thuray and Sonda Tise both came third to win bronze.

Oladimeji Busayo defeated Paul Oshime to win the U17 Female Foil event.


The U17 Men's Epee was won by Femi Dipo defeating Ajumobi Damilare. Olagunju Zaafir came third to win bronze.
