Decisions of the Executive Committee

Following the meeting of the Executive Committee in Lausanne (SUI) on September 22 2019, please see below and attached the decisions taken:

1. 2019-2020 Season

The referees, the supervisors and the Presidents of the DT for the Grand Prix have been appointed and will be contacted directly by the Sport Department.

2. 2019 test event and 2020 Olympic Games

Please find attached the list of referees and officials appointed for the 2019 test event and the 2020 Tokyo Olympic Games.

3. Veterans Council

Mr Antonio Melo (VEN) was nominated to join the Council as a member, following the death of Mr. Gregorio Lima (PUR).

4. Affiliation of new federations
