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We have the pleasure to invite you to the international tournament, world-cup individual and team to be hosted in Luxembourg. (Centre National d'Escrime, complexe sportif du Lycée de Garçons 62 Avenue Victor Hugo, 1750 Luxembourg).

Organising committee :

Ad hoc group formed by the FIE - DFB - FLE - FFE

The tournament is open to all fencers with a valid FIE licence for the 2019-2020 season. Participation is governed according to 0.61 of the rulebook.

The organising committee will make the required arrangements for the referees designated by the FIE. Teams do not need to bring referees.

The FIE rules apply throughout the competition. Given the exceptional situation the organising committee will follow-up with detailed information as soon as they become available

Coronavirus:

In order to help the WHO and national authorities to protect against propagation of the SARS-CoV-2 virus, the pathogen for the COVID-19 disease, you are required to follow the recommendations of the WHO.

These are available in Arabic, Mandarin, English, French and Russian at the WHO website. (https://www.who.int/emergencies/diseases/novel-coronavirus-2019/advice-for-public).

Reading them and instructing your teams accordingly is an important step in this unusual situation as we must react swiftly and efficiently.

Basic protective measures (WHO, recommendation):

- No spectators will be admitted
- Wash your hands frequently - use water or alcohol-based sanitizing lotions
- . Maintain social distance - salute will only be done by weapon
- Avoid touching eyes, nose and mouth these are the main ports of entry for the virus
- React at the first symptoms (fever, cough, difficulty breathing) – see your doctor for further advise.

Please be informed that the organising committe will enforce any additional measures put in place by the local authorities of Luxembourg.

Timetable:

Friday 6.3.2020 (Individual World Cup) 9h30 registration and payment of entry fees - Weapon control 11h30 pools to be followed up by DE tables

Saturday, 7.3.2020 (Individual World Cup) 11h30 DE of 64 16h00 Semi-Final 17h00 Medal ceremony

Sunday, 8.3.2020(team World Cup) 10h00 start of DE 32 16h00 final 17h00 Medal ceremony

Entry fee is \in 60 per fencer and \in 400 per team - it has to be paid on the spot in cash Anti-doping control will be done according to the rules.

Arrival and transfer to Luxembourg

If you arrive in Frankfurt you will be welcomed by volunteers who will guide you to the buses to Luxembourg. The travel by bus takes approx. 3 hours.

We will then drive you to your hotels. A shuttle service from the hotels will be organised and displayed in the hotels.

The currency in Luxembourg is Euro – acceptance of other currencies is at the discretion of the business but rather unlikely outside the Airport.

If you want to use public transport you can look up everything at https://www.mobiliteit.lu/en/ - there is also an app for this service on iOS and Android.

In Luxembourg public transport is free of charge – which means that you can use it without needing a ticket.

CAVEAT1: If you want to use first-class you will however need a ticket. CAVEAT2: Buses will likely refuse large groups with fencing bags during rush hours. Use the tram!



Taxis are rather expensive in Luxembourg, you cannot hail them but you can call them via the app hellotaxi.lu. There's also no Uber in Luxembourg.

Map








The venue is at Luxembourg Limpersberg (click the map to see in google maps or paste the link in your browser)
