Decisions of the Executive Committee

Following the meeting of the Executive Committee held by video conference on 18 September 2020, please see below and enclosed the decisions taken:

1. 2020-2021 Calendar

1.a Resumption of competitions

The FIE Executive Committee has reassessed the world situation linked to the COVID-19 according to the following criteria:

- Entry/health/medical/visa/travel restrictions globally and in countries hosting competitions
- Appropriate training for athletes

The FIE Medical Commission was also consulted. The current situation in the world is as follows: health regulations and provisions remain very different from country to country and are in a state of permanent fluctuation. Quarantines and other binding sanitary measures are sometimes mandatory. There are significant travel and traffic restrictions. Athlete training has not resumed its normal pace in a number of countries. Some organisers canceled their competitions in November or December while others are not yet able to confirm them.

In the light of the above, and in order to protect the health of athletes and participants and not to penalise any federation, the FIE Executive Committee decided to postpone the date for the resumption of competitions to 1 January 2021.

The FIE Sport Department will send the current calendar to all Federations, as well as an explanatory chart showing how the senior rankings will work for the current season.

The Executive Committee has taken the measures below to help overcome current difficulties and to allow tournaments to resume under satisfactory conditions.

1.b 2021 Global support plan in the context of COVID-19.

A 2021 support plan is being analysed. It will be decided and communicated in the next weeks.

1.c FIE outline of risk-mitigation requirements in the context of COVID-19

The document has been updated with a summary of the updates on page 4 and changes shown in the body of the text.

1.d Designations for the current season

Please find attached the designations of referees and Refereeing Delegates, as well as DT Presidents and Event Managers for the Grand Prix.

1.e Season supervisors

Registrations for supervisors will be open in the following weeks and a communication about this subject will be sent to all those concerned by the Sport Department.

1.f Tokyo Olympic Games

The referees and officials who were to officiate in 2020 will be contacted to confirm their availability for 2021, so that we can release the final list to Tokyo by the end of September 2020.
