A new stage in the international program of training seminars on the FIE refereeing rules in the Pan American continent.

The Pan American Fencing Confederation, with the support of the FIE, is organizing a series of training seminars on the FIE refereeing rules.

This time, the online seminars will be organized strictly by the type of weapon (Epee, Foil, Sabre), and they will be held in a new format.

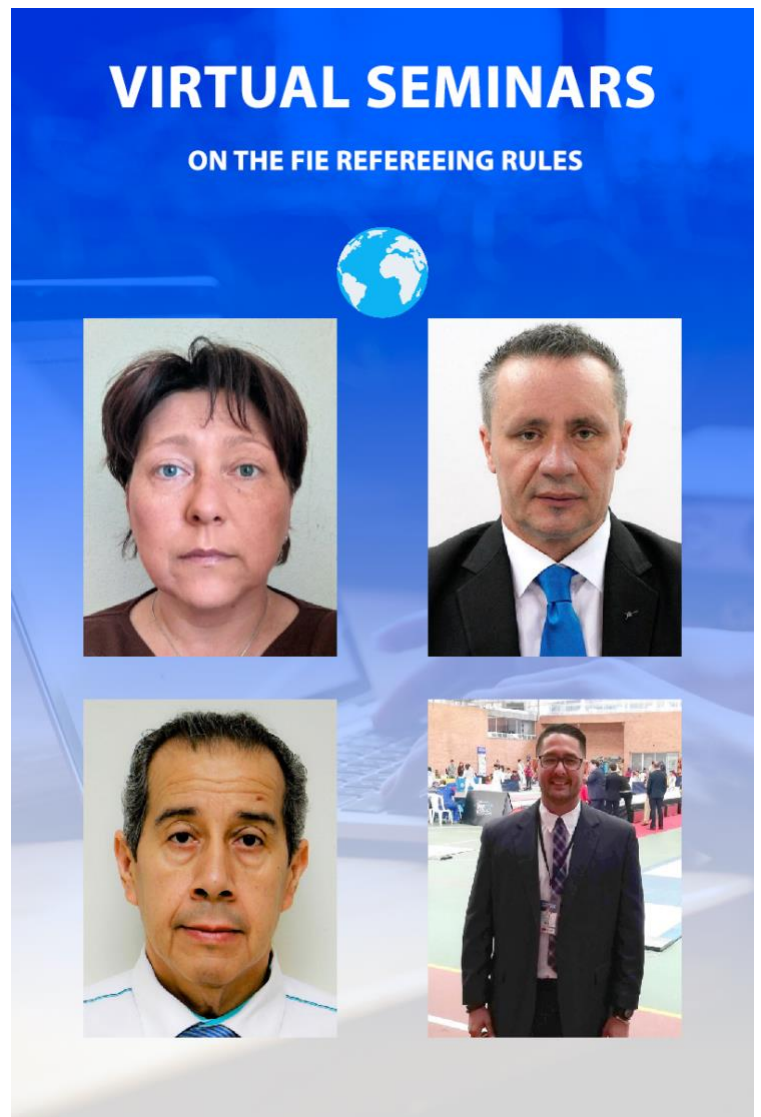
Three different groups will participate in the training simultaneously:

The first group of participants carries the national referees of the FIE. The second group of participants consists of coaches who always need to know about changes in the rules and regulations of the FIE competition, and the third group holds athletes who must be well aware of their rights and responsibilities during FIE competitions.

Thus, the new training format will provide an opportunity to expand the audience of students and help to update the knowledge of not only the national referees of the FIE, but also the knowledge of coaches and athletes, which is an important factor in achieving high results for fencers at international competitions.

During this difficult period of the pandemic, the CPE seeks the active participation, not only of the referees, but also of the athletes and coaches in virtual training, and that they communicate online with colleagues, and other countries.

The CPE will hold a number of seminars for all the NFFs from our continent. This time, it is planned to conduct each of the training seminars simultaneously for three to four national federations from the Pan American continent.

The first series of seminars on the FIE refereeing Rules will be organized on Epee. The first seminar starts on November 21, 2020.
