All passengers arriving in Estonia by plane must have filled in the <u>traveller's questionnaire</u> before arriving in Estonia. It can be completed up to three days before arriving in Estonia.

Arrival days: November 17-18, 2021

COVID-19 test, and accreditations are performed at the official hotel Radisson Blu Hotel Olümpia (Liivalaia 33, 10118 Tallinn) from November 17 to 21, 2021.

According to <u>FIE requirements</u>, every participant must complete one rapid antigen test upon arrival, including for vaccinated or Covid-19 recovered participants. The test must be performed on every 4th day after arrival day, unless that 4th day is the day of departure of the participant.

Participants who receive a negative result of the rapid antigen test and who have completed and signed upon arrival the Covid-19 Acknowledgement of risk and release from liability (Appendix B) and the Screening Questionnaire (Appendix C) will get the accreditation (wristband) and will be allowed to enter competition.





Departure tests - participants needing a Covid-19 test to go back to their home country must inform the organizer's test station and make an appointment according to their departure time. These tests are at the expense of participants. Test prices and information about the registration will be added soon.

General exception decided by the Estonian Government for athletes and members of sports delegations participating in international competitions:

According to the general exception, athletes and members of sports delegations who are not vaccinated or have recovered from COVID-19 can participate in training activities and competitions even if they have been in close contact with an infected person if they test negative themselves. Formula and equipment: According to the rules of the FIE.

Referees: The referees are designated by the FIE and organizers. Delegations will not have to provide any referees.

Weapon control:

- Epee (max 4)
- Mask (max 2)
- Body wire (max 4)
- Glove (max 2)





Participation: Each national federation may enter a maximum of 12 fencers. The organizing country may enter up to 20 fencers plus the number needed to make up the pools. Entries via www.fie.org website. A valid 2021/2022 season FIE license is obligatory. **NB! Participants under**18 must have fulfilled authorization for minors at the first day of competition

Entry fee:

- **60 EUR/fencer** for individual competition (to be paid on November 18th 15:00 h 20:00 or November 19th 08:30 h 09:30 h)
- **400 EUR/team** for team competition (to be paid on November 20^{th} 10:00 h 15:00 h).

Anti-doping Control: Anti-doping Control according to the rules of the FIE.

Visa: Federations who need a visa to enter Estonia should contact the consulates or embassies in their country on time. If you require an official letter of invitation for your visa, please send your request to – <u>info@mook.ee</u>

Transport:

The distance between the Tallinn airport and Olümpia hotel is 4km.
