We have the pleasure to invite you to participate in the Héraklész Budapest Cup, Junior World Cup in men's and women's sabre in memoriam György Gerevich, that will take place in Budapest on January 7-8, 2022.

**ENTRY**: The World Cup is open to all junior fencers with a 2021-2022 FIE license. Inscription must take place on the FIE website, according to FIE rules and deadlines.

**FORMULA:** The Rules of the FIE apply; One qualifying round of pools, a direct elimination table to qualify for a final by direct elimination. Video refereeing will be available on the final piste.

**REFEREES**: In accordance with the FIE Rules the number of FIE A or B Grade referees that must accompany teams to competitions is:

1–4 fencers No obligation to provide a referee

5–9 fencers One referee 10 or more fencers Two referees

For junior A Grade competitions, the name(s) of the referee(s) (who must have an FIE category in the weapon of the competition for which they are entered) must be notified via the FIE website 7 days before the competition (midnight, Lausanne time). If the referee quota requirement is not fulfilled, **1000 Euro** has to be paid for every missing referee (cf o.31.)

07:30-09:00 Weapon control (women's sabre) and Covid Rapid testing

09:00: Beginning of the qualification pools of men's sabre followed by the direct elimination table

**ENTRY FEE**: An entry fee of € 25 per fencer will be given to the organizers during Registration.

**DOPING**: Doping control will be done according to FIE rules.

**VISA:** Kindly check for visa requirements to Hungary before making your ticket reservations. Those who need an invitation letter for visa support, please contact <a href="mailto:benedek.soproniszabo@hunfencing.hu">benedek.soproniszabo@hunfencing.hu</a>

**COVID regulations:** EU Digital COVID Certificates are accepted.

Otherwise entry to the territory of Hungary in passenger traffic is only allowed to pursue business or economic activities (including sports, in this case you need to provide proof of the purpose of your stay). Participants need to provide an official PCR test result (in English) to the border officials upon arrival to Hungary. The sample taken must not be older than 72 hours at the time of arrival. Regardless of the passenger's citizenship, the restrictions do not apply to travellers:

- recovered from COVID-19 in the last 6 months from the date of entry;
- holding a Hungarian immunity certificate and their accompanying minor children (only if they travel together);
- holding an immunity certificate that is recognised by Hungary based on unilateral/bilateral
  agreements (see the <u>list of these countries</u>), and their accompanying minor children (only if
  they travel together);
- arriving to Hungary through land borders from Serbia, excluding the case of entry by civil aircraft:
- crossing the border in relation to freight traffic;
- crossing the border with a diplomatic passport, foreign service passport, service passport and seaman's passport;
- presenting a negative PRC result in English or in Hungarian, performed within 72 hours from the







time of entry, in one of the following countries:

- EU or EU candidate states;
- OECD member states;
- NATO member states;
- o Russia;
- o China;
- United Arab Emirates;
- o Bahrain;
- o member states of The Cooperation Council of Turkic Speaking States.

Travellers fulfilling one of the above mentioned criteria do not need any permission in order to enter Hungary, they do not need to go into isolation, and their length of stay is not limited.

The Covid regulations of the FIE will be in effect, in case of changes Up to date regulations will be communicated to participants before/during the event. https://fie.org/fie/documents/other-documents

Also, please bring the filled and signed "Appendix B" (COVID-19 ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF RISK AND RELEASE FROM LIABILITY) and "Appendix C" (COVID-19 SCREENING QUESTIONNAIRE FOR FIE EVENT) of the FIE outline of risk-mitigation requirements for each participant.
