Participation



Alt 1.

For Individual World Cup competitions, each national federation may enter a maximum of 12 fencers. The organising country may enter up to 20 fencers plus the number needed to make up the pools.

Alt 2.

Team participation is open to all countries and limited to one team per weapon per country.

Entry

Every competitor is required to be licensed for the 2021-2022 season. No fencer is allowed to take part in an official event of the FIE unless he or she is at least 13 years old on 1 January in the year of the competition.

Entries of fencers, teams and referees can only be made at the FIE website, www.fie.org, respecting the deadlines specified in the FIE Rules (cf. o.54).



Entry fee

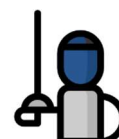


Individual competition: **EUR 60**. Team competition: **EUR 400**.

The entry fee is to be paid in cash at registration (accreditation) after the results of the tests.

Referee Obligation

The referees are designated by the FIE and delegations will not have to provide any referees.



Formula

Individual competitions



One qualifying round of pools, a preliminary direct elimination table, a main direct elimination table of 64 fencers to qualify for a final by direct elimination.

Team competitions

Integral direct elimination with a direct elimination table which may be incomplete. All places in the table up to 16th place will be fought for. From 17th place onwards teams will be classified, within each round of the table, according to their initial place in the table. The first four teams will be placed in the direct elimination table according to the current official team ranking of the FIE (cf. o.86); the remaining ranked teams will be placed in the table by drawing of lots in pairs. The teams that are not classified will occupy the last places in the table and will be separated by drawing of lots (cf. o.42-o.47).



Doping

Doping control will be done according to FIE rules.

ENTRY VISA TO RUSSIA

RUSSIAN VISAS FOR PARTICIPANTS & OFFICIALS

Most nations in the world require a visa to visit Russia

We are pleased to inform you that the Russian Foreign Ministry has approved a special facilitated visa procedure for all categories of participants of the 2022 **International Fencing Tournament**, i.e.

- athletes,
- members of the official delegations,
- international technical officials (referees),
- FIE Family members and official guests,
- as well as media representatives.

All the Russian Consulates throughout the world have been notified of the above procedure. According to it the visas are to be issued on a priority basis, i.e. within three days from the date of application (or on the same day if necessary) at any Russian Consulate regardless of citizenship.

According to this procedure, you are to make a request for the visa support on the official paper of your National Federation signed by the President or the General Secretary.

At the same time you have to complete the below visa template with the personal passport information of the members of your delegations

ACCREDITATION, ACCOMMODATION, MEALS AND TRANSFER

The username and password for completing the accreditation process and requiring accommodation, meals and transfer will be sent together with the link after receiving the request from you to the following email:

COVID-19 SPECIFIC RULES

It is mandatory to all participants to follow the rules:

- Covid-19 PCR tests must be done not earlier than 48 hours before the arrival time to Russian Federation, to be presented printed to the boarder control authorities
- Accreditation cards will only be given to participants that provided a negative test result
- Visas, Transfer and Hotel Booking must be done ONLY through the mentioned in the invitation letter contacts
- Tickets and passport copies must be provided in advance for entering the country, as the list of the names has to be obtained by the authorities (on the border)
- If it is needed to be tested before the departure to the home country, you need to inform the organizers about it in advance, expenses for it to be covered by each National Federation.
- Transportation and logistics must be in line with protocol guidelines, a service is planned to and from the official hotels to the competition venue.
- COVID-19 specific rules of the FIE apply to all participants, please read it carefully: https://static.fie.org/uploads/25/128849-FIE_outline_risk-mitig_Covid-19_September%202021_ang.pdf
- No spectators will be allowed to the competition venue
- According to FIE requirements all participants should pass one test upon arrival at the Venue, including for vaccinated or Covid-19 recovered participants. The test must be performed every 4 days after arrival day, unless that 4th day is the day of departure of the participant. Participants who receive a negative result of the test and who have completed and signed upon arrival APPENDIX B AND C <https://fie.org/fie/documents/other-documents> will be allowed to enter competition.
