Decisions of the Executive Committee

Following the Executive Committee meeting held in Lausanne (SUI) on 28 May 2022, please find below and appended the decisions made:

1. Competition calendar

In line with Information letter 9-22, the calendar for the season 2022-2023 has been established, and though some competitions have not yet been confirmed, the calendar will soon be published on the FIE website.

In order to establish a continuity during the Olympic qualification period, the calendar for the season 2022-2023 will be reconducted for the season 2023-2024, with as few changes as possible.

2. Modifications to the Administrative Rules

Several articles related to the calendar of competitions were updated and amended: 2.5.1; 2.5.1.1; 2.5.1.3; 2.5.1.4; 2.5.1.5; 2.5.1.6.

3. FIE Sport and Technical Director

Mr Dieter Lammer (GER) was hired as FIE Sport and Technical Director until 2024, starting from September 1st, 2022.

4. Veterans Council

Mr Peter Brigola (AUT) was nominated to join the Veterans Council as a member, following the death of Mr Mark Rance (NZL). The Veterans Council then met virtually and elected Mr Benoit Pincemaille (FRA) as President.

5. Designations for the 2022 Veterans World Championships

Please find attached the list of officials nominated, established on the basis of proposals from the Veterans Council and the corresponding Commissions.

6. 2022 Safeguarding webinar

A FIE Safeguarding Webinar 2022 will be organised on the 23rd of June (Thursday), for Commissions, Councils and Executive Committee Members.

7. Environment: FIE Annual Day

In compliance with the mission stated in article 1.1 k) of the FIE Statutes, the Executive Committee decided to establish an FIE "Fencing for the Planet" Day, which will take place each year on Saturday of the second weekend in April.

This day aims at encouraging the fencing family to join or put in place initiatives and actions to protect the environment, and at giving visibility to the contributions of the fencing family which will be celebrated around the globe.
