REGULATIONS All FIE rules will be strictly enforced.

LICENSE All fencers must have valid FIE license.

ENTRY FEE €35 or 250 DKK to be paid cash, credit card or mobilepay at registration desk.

If the required number of referees is not respected a fine of 1000 € per missing referee must be paid prior to the tournament start.

The fine will be reduced to 500 € if the organization of Trekanten International is clearly informed by email at tournament@trekanten.org about the failure to present the required referee(s) no less that 15 days before the tournament.

ENTRY

FIE rules apply: - applies for EFC U23 as well!

Entry only via your national federation no later than Sept. 30th 2022.

COVID 19 RULES

In accordance to the decision of FIE COMEX, following measures will be implemented during competition:

- Obligatory Facemask wearing, except when fencing, training and eating.
- All participants will need to present the organizers with the negative result of one Covid-19 test (PCR or RAT Rapid Antigen Test), performed within maximum 72 hours before arriving in Denmark.

If the COVID-19 situation gets worse FIE might revise measures, in which case the above will be revised accordingly.

We remind you to have "COVID-19 ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF RISK AND RELEASE FROM LIABILITY" (enclosed Appendix A) prepared and presented upon entry to competition for all direct or indirect participants.

APPENDIX A COVID-19 ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF RISK AND RELEASE FROM LIABILITY
