ACTIVITY REPORT

Point 1 / Item1 / Punto 1: Survey for NFs

1) A survey with 26 questions organised in 3 areas was prepared, to poll all the NFs.

Surveymonkey will automatically analyze the results and on the basis of this automatic analysis an article highlighting findings and conclusions will be drafted. The survey to the NFs will help to identify the weakest areas so that ad hoc actions can be tailored. A member of the WG will carry out the task to draft the article (member to be defined).

Point 2 /Item 2 / Punto 2: ATHLETES AMBASSADORS

2) The process to select athletes ambassadors from all the zones must be defined.

It is suggested to let open the number of athletes that want to be ambassadors for "Fencing and Environment", so that all the zones and all the areas of interest can be covered.

Athletes ambassadors may be mainly employed in awareness raising programs and activities on social media. Possibility to award a diploma to recognize the commitment of the involved athletes, similar to DYFG diploma or diploma for nominees of the Fair Play trophy that do not receive the final award.



Point 3 / Item 3 / Punto 3: SHARM EL SHEIK SUMMIT

3) A request to participate to the summit in Sharm-el-Sheik at the beginning of November was already forwarded. No official reply was issued so far. For consistency with the mission of the group and the principles of sustainability, it was agreed that FIE should be represented by the members already present in the organizing country.

Point 5 / Item 5 / Punto 5: WORKING PLAN FOR 2023

1) WEBINAR FOR NFs and competition organisers

The project of a webinar for NFs about sustainability and environmental protection was discussed. The webinar could be scheduled for the end of January, so that the WG will have time to analyze the results of the survey to the NF and customize it according to the needs.

The webinar should target NF and competition organizers.

The possibility to invite a speaker from IOC Department of Corporate Development, Brand and Sustainability was discussed.

A possible period to organize the webinar could be end of January 2023.

2)) DYFG program at zonal level

The DYFG program should be replicated also at continental level. This would allow to benefit those countries that do not apply for the program because they do not attend the world championships. The administrative part for the application and the legal framework should be run by the Confederation. As a SEMI Delegate is always present at the zonal championships, to check the donated equipment would be feasible.

3)) Communication plan

It is necessary to coordinate with CMTV department and in particular with the Digital Communication Manager, so that all the actions of the Working Group, but also the initiatives of NFs, athletes and clubs enjoy the right visibility.
