# **Dear President,**

2011 Junior and Cadet World Championships, Dead sea (Jordan)

These Championships will be organised from March 29 to April 6, 2011.

#### a) entries, reminder

Nominative entry of fencers, teams and official must be done via the FIE Web Site, by the deadline stipulated in article o.53 of the FIE Rules.

The entries **over quota** of Presidents and General Secretaries of national federations, FIE Commission members, FIE Confederation Presidents, FIE Executive Committee members and members of honour of the FIE are also now done **directly by their national federations via the FIE Web Site**. The entry process is explained in the "Help" feature of the FIE Web Site.

#### b) Photos - accreditations

## To ensure that the accreditations of officials and athletes are processed:

- the photos of all officials must be sent to: s.lange-derkum@ophardt-team.org
- national federations which did not already upload the photos of their <u>athletes</u>, <u>President and General Secretary</u> to the FIE Web Site must do so <u>before February 28</u>, 2011.

The entries and accreditations are closed 15 days before the date of the first event of the Championships at the latest. After this date, a fine of 150 Euros will be imposed to any entry or accreditation.

#### c) Entry fees

The national federations must pay entry fees directly to the Championship organisers.

## d) Payments due, reminder

Following article 10.2.2 of the FIE Statutes, a member federation which is not up to date with its financial obligations towards the FIE at midday the day before the opening of a Cadet, Junior, Senior or Veteran World Championship may not participate in this World Championship, unless exception is justified and granted by the Executive Committee.
