2024 JUNIOR AND CADET WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS IN RIYADH (KSA)

1. Visas and travel requirements

3. Room reservations, transfers, entry fees

4. Entries and accreditations, reminder (cf. Handbook of regulations)

The quota of officials who may be brought by the federations is 75% of the number of fencers entered in the individual competitions.

The nominative entries for the athletes, teams and officials (including coaches) must be made on the website of the FIE www.fie.org, in accordance with the deadline set out in Article o.56 of the Rules: no later than 15 days (midnight Lausanne time) before the first event in the championships. For any entry/accreditation after the deadline for an athlete, a team or an official, a fine will be imposed.

Parents accompanying athletes will not register on the FIE website. They will be accredited directly with the organizers outside and in addition to the quota for each delegation. A personal photo of the parents accompanying athletes should be sent via email at the latest on March, 1st, 2024 for accreditation to: accreditation@riyadh2024.org

5. Photos

The national federations must upload onto the www.fie.org website the photos of their athletes, officials, Presidents and General Secretaries before **March 15th, 2024**. The accreditation system will be handled by Fencing sport (fencingaccreditations@gmail.com).

Format of the photos: .jpg, 30*40mm.

Names of the photo files (as in the following example): ITA_SURNAME_firstname_chief of delegation.jpg

6. Payments due

It will be possible to make the payments due to the FIE (if any) from the 10.04.2024 to the 15.04.2024 at the accreditation desk.

7. LED lighting system in masks

It was decided to use a LED lighting system in masks as an additional repetition of the hits during the semi-final/final in individual bouts and finals of team matches of the 2024 Junior and Cadet World Championships. This LED lighting system was previously implemented in international competitions, and its use at the 2024 Junior and Cadet World Championships will be supervised by the SEMI Commission.

The necessary equipment will be provided to the fencers.

The LED lighting system in the mask is only a repetition of the hits and has no impact on the scoring machine.
