January 3-5, 2024



Ibague it's a municipality Colombian located in the center-west of Colombia, on the Central Andes Mountains between the Combeima Canyon and the Magdalena Valley, near the Snowy Mountains of Tolima.

It is the capital of the department of Tolima It is located at an average altitude of 1285 m above sea level. It was founded on October 14, 1550 by the Spanish captain Andres Lopez de Galarza as Villa de San Bonifacio de Ibagué del Valle de las Lanzas, which makes it one of the oldest cities in America. For being a capital departmental, houses the Government of Tolima, the Palace of Justice, the Departmental Assembly, the departmental headquarters of the Office of the Attorney General of the Nation It is the main political, industrial, commercial, cultural and financial epicenter of the department.









The average temperature in Ibague for the month of January is 18° / 12°C

In Colombia the common voltage is 110 V. The frequency is 60 Hz. The plugs and sockets are of type A / B.

PLACES TO VISIT



COMBEIMA CANYON

The Combeima Canyon is one of the most attractive tourist sites in the city of Ibagué. Along the way you can find many restaurants and places where you can try some of the typical dishes and snacks of the region.

Nowadays, public transport can reach the vereda de juntas and from there on the path must be covered on foot, around which you can find a truly impressive panorama full of nature and fresh air. Crossing this path you can find 3 representative sites of the area:

The viewpoint of the combeima canyon: This is a small viewpoint located approximately 5 minutes from Vereda de Juntas, where you can see all the vegetation and the sidewalks near the area. It is a very pleasant view that is constantly visited by both locals and tourists.









La Riviera Estate: It is a striking farm restaurant that is approximately 30 minutes from the Vereda de Juntas. To access this restaurant you must pass between 2 mountains via a cable car located in the area especially for this purpose.

El Rancho Hot Springs: Following the main road you will reach the route to the Nevado del Tolima. During this journey you will find the Ranch, a site where you can access a cold water waterfall and natural hot springs. This has long been a major tourist attraction in the area, but it is currently advisable to check if the site is still in operation before setting off.

MARTINIQUE MUSEUM PARK



If you have an excellent camera, you will be able to take different shots, not only of the beautiful landscapes that you can find along the entire route of any trail, but also of the majestic city of Ibagué.









One of the excellent plans to do in Martinique is to climb up to the repeater towers. Although the path can be long and your physical condition will be put to the test, it will be worth it, since at various points along the way you will be able to see the entire city from viewpoints, and when you reach the repeater towers (the highest point) you will see one of the most beautiful images of the city of Ibagué.

Date: January 3-5, 2025.

Place: Major Coliseum of Ibagué, Colombia.

Formula: In accordance with FIE Regulations.

Individual event: group elimination, direct elimination bracket until the final (cf. o.35-o.41).

Team events: Complete knockout draw, which may be incomplete. Eleven places in the draw will be contested up to 16th place. From 17th place onwards, teams will be ranked in each round of the draw according to their initial position in the draw. The first four teams will be placed in the knockout round according to the current official FIE team ranking (cf. o.86); the other qualified teams will be placed in the draw in pairs. The unqualified teams will occupy the last places in the draw and will be drawn in pairs (cf. o.42-o.47).

Doping: Anti-doping control will be carried out in accordance with FIE regulations.

Stake: Each national federation can present a maximum of 12 fencers.

For individual World Cup tournaments outside Europe, the host country may field up to 30 fencers plus the number of fencers needed to fill the pools.

Participation in team events is open to all Federations and is limited to one team per weapon and per country.









Registrations: The Cup is open to all fencers with a valid license for the 2024-2025 season.

No fencer may participate in an official FIE competition unless he or she is at least 13 years old on 1 January of the year of the competition. Participants in all official FIE junior individual and team events must be under 20 years of age at midnight on 31 December of the year preceding

the tournament year (cf. o.80).

Registration of fencers, teams and referees must be done on the FIE website, www.fie.org, respecting the deadlines specified in the FIE regulations (cf. o.54).

Referees: Participating countries must be accompanied by an FIE A and B licensed referee, as indicated below (cf. t.35). Delegations that do not respect the quota will be sanctioned with a fine of 1,000.00 EUR per referee.
