Formula and Equipment

According to FIE regulations and rules

Referees

"Each country is required to send FIE qualified referees in accordance with FIE rule o.25.1: 5-9 fencers 1 referee; 10 or more fencers 2 referees. The name(s) of the referee(s) must be notified via the FIE website 7 days before the competition (midnight, Lausanne time).

If the required number of referees is not respected a fine of 1000 Euro per referee has to be paid to the organiser by the federation (o.25.2 and o.31)."
