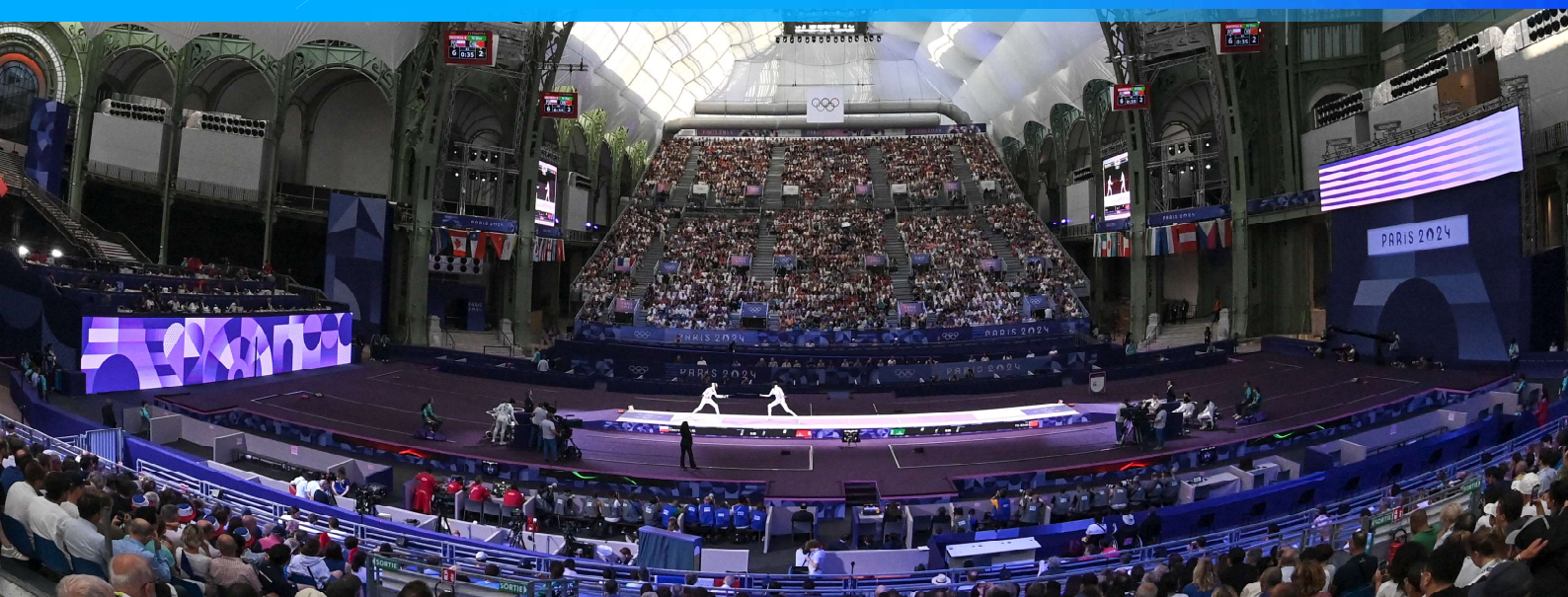

The International Fencing Federation has been affected by the loss of several friends, and it is with deep sadness that the FIE has learned of the passing of:



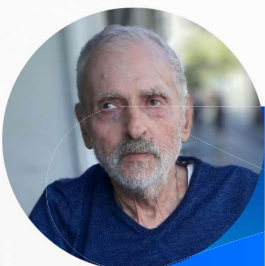
Henri Sassine

**(CAN)
1940 - 2024**

The fencing master Henri Sassine (CAN) on Feb. 11, 2024, in Laval, Quebec. A Canadian national team coach, his work included coaching at the Olympic Games in Los Angeles 1984, Seoul 1988, Barcelona 1992, Atlanta 1996 and Rio 2016. Remarkably, he trained Olympians in all three weapons.

Born on Oct. 8, 1940, in Egypt, Sassine emigrated to Canada in 1966, settling in Chibougamau, Northern Quebec, where he coached many fencers. From 1984, nine of his fencers became Olympians, including his daughter, Sandra, who competed in Beijing and London. He also trained Olympians Claude Marcil, Jacynthe Poirier, Daniel Perreault, Jean-Marie Banos, Jean-Paul Banos, Tony Plourde, Evens Gravel and Maximilien Van Haaster. The Banos brothers were renowned for being four-time Olympians.

The Canadian Fencing Federation stated, "Master Sassine was not only a Canadian fencing legend, but also a great friend of the Pan-American family, as evidenced by his many collaborations with the Cuban Fencing Federation, among others."



Arthur Bar-Joseph

**(ISR, MH, HOF)
1936 - 2024**

Arthur Bar-Joseph (ISR), an FIE Member of Honour and of the Hall of Fame, FIE Olympic and world championships referee and Refereeing Commission member, on March 2.

Born on June 15, 1936, in Romania, he emigrated to Israel in the 1960s, where he became involved with fencing at the Maccabi Ramat-Gan Fencing Club.

He went on to work in international fencing, and as an FIE referee from 1972 with an A rating in foil and epee and a B in sabre. He was appointed, as a referee or a refereeing delegate, to five consecutive Olympic Games: Los Angeles 1984, Seoul 1988, Barcelona 1992, Atlanta 1996 and Sydney 2000. He was the organiser of multiple international competitions and worked as an observer in numerous FIE Fencing World Championships.

Bar-Joseph was a member of the FIE Refereeing Commission from 1986 until 2004.

He was appointed Member of Honour at the 2013 Congress in Paris for spending his life promoting fencing and refereeing in Israel.

Bar-Joseph was the President of Honour of the Israeli Fencing Association and served as chairperson of the Referee Committee and promoted Fair Play.

Considered by many to be the founding father of epee in Israel, Bar-Joseph established the first epee club in the country, in the town of Ashkelon, where it grew to be the largest in the country. He was a fencing coach and one of the first Israeli epee coaches. In addition, he was renowned for promoting refereeing and initiating refereeing examinations for coaches and athletes in the country.

Bar-Joseph's two sons, Haim and Shay, who are former fencers and the latter an FIE referee with an A in epee and B in foil since 1993, said they "were and forever [will be] proud of him, his achievements, and his commitment to the sport he loved so much. Fencing was his whole life."



Mourad Klioua

(ALG)

1944 – 2024

Mourad Klioua (ALG) on March 1, 2024. A Category B FIE referee in three weapons, he officiated at numerous international competitions.

Klioua was a former member of the Executive Board of the Algerian Fencing Federation and for several years served as Chairman of the Algerian Federation Referees' Commission. Over the decades, he trained numerous referees to officiate nationally and internationally.

He was born in 1944 and was known affectionately to his friends and family as "Uncle Mourad". An excellent fencer as well as coach and trainer, he began his fencing career with the Gendarmerie Nationale in 1967. He was Algerian fencing champion several times and was the Arab sabre champion and fenced on the Algerian national team. He later went on to coach sabre for his club and then for the Algerian national team.

An announcement from the Algerian Fencing Federation stated "Mr. Mourad Klioua will leave a great void in the Algerian fencing family".



James Williams

(GBR)

1966 – 2024

James Williams, former Team GB fencer, aged 57 following a short-term illness on Sunday 12 May. Williams represented his homeland at the Olympic Games in Barcelona, Atlanta, and Sydney.

He took up the sport during his time in the military, quickly becoming a well-respected member of the fencing community.

After his retirement from the sport, Williams turned his attention to public service, joining Medway Council in 2017 where he would serve as the Director of Public Health.

"I will always remember him for his larger-than-life presence, his humour and, above all, his humanity and kindness," said Dr Anjan Ghosh, director of public health for Kent County Council.

Further tributes have been paid by his colleagues, with councillor Teresa Murray describing Williams as 'an Olympian in all sense of the word.'

"His passion for focusing on building resilience within communities and his focus on intervention at an early stage to prevent the development of poor health has meant that the people of Medway are leading better, healthier lives as a result of his hard work."



Guram Kostava

(GEO)
1937-2024

Guram Kostava (GEO) at the age of 87, who was a world champion and Olympic medallist.

Fencing on the Soviet team, Kostava earned two World Championships gold medals in men's team epee in 1961 and 1967. He also earned two Olympic bronze medals, one in team (Rome, 1960) and another in individual (Tokyo, 1964). Also, in team epee he earned a World Championships silver medal in 1959, followed by bronze medals in 1963 and 1965.

Kostava was champion of the Soviet Union in men's individual epee (1961) and earned five silver medals (1960, 1961, 1962, 1964, 1968) and five bronze medals (1957, 1958, 1960, 1965, 1967). He was the Soviet Union Cup winner in 1960 and named a "knight of sports" in 2016.

"After leaving his active sports career with glory, Guram Kostava was always where Georgian fencing needed him", stated the Georgian Fencing Federation. *"He was extremely fond of fencing and a fan of every fencer."*

Kostava was born in Tbilisi, Georgia on June 18, 1937. He graduated from the Institute of Physical Culture of Georgia.



Nicolas Lullien

(FRA)
1947 – 2024

Maître Nicolas Lullien (FRA) on July 25 at the age of 77. Under his leadership, his club, Tour d'Auvergne, won 14 medals at World Championships, multiple victories in World Cup competitions and three world championship titles in different categories by his students, Olivier Lambert, Antoinette Willard and Laurent Bel. Five Olympic athlete selections resulted from his coaching.

Lullien was awarded the Medal of Honour of the French Fencing Federation for his “remarkable human and pedagogical qualities and the brilliant results obtained by the licensees of his only club, the Tour d’Auvergne in Paris”, presented in 2023.

Following retirement, in 2023 his club was quoted about his award: “We are happy, proud and grateful that the French Fencing Federation honors a man who has embodied excellence in the world of fencing. Nicolas Lullien is a fencing master and an exceptional man, whose talent and passion have left an unforgettable mark on the history of the club and on all the students and colleagues who have had the chance to meet him and benefit from his teaching.”

In all, with his club, more than 109 medals, including 35 titles, were won by Laurent Bel, Christophe Bel, Antoinette Willard, Cyril Lacroix, Christina Cerny, Julie Anne Gross and Xavier Ali, among other members. Lullien was also called a “literary man passionate about ancient and artistic fencing, and he set up ‘La Salle d’Armes’ at the Tour d’Auvergne, which became the leading club in France for artistic fencing.”



**Dr. Bassam Abbas
Muhammad**

(IRQ)
1950 -2024

Dr. Bassam Abbas Muhammad (IRQ). He was born in 1950 and was Vice President of the Iraqi Fencing Federation and a national team fencer from 1974 to 1980.

According to an announcement from the Iraqi Fencing Federation, Bassam “was a prominent figure in the world of Iraqi fencing, as he contributed his efforts and experience to developing fencing and enhancing its position in Iraq. His loss represents a great loss not only to family, but also to everyone who knew and worked with him in the field of sports.”



Peter Westbrook

(USA)
1952 – 2024

Peter Westbrook (USA, HoF), who passed away on November 29, at the age of 72. He competed in five Olympic Games in men’s sabre and earned an individual bronze medal at the 1984 Games in Los Angeles.

He was born on April 16, 1952, in St. Louis, Missouri, and grew up in Newark, New Jersey. He began fencing at the Essex Catholic High School and then competed while attending New York University. Between 1974 and 1995, Westbrook won 13 USA national men’s sabre titles, including eight consecutively between 1979 and 1986. He became a member of the FIE Hall of Fame in addition to being inducted into the USA

Fencing Hall of Fame, New York University Athletics Hall of Fame, Sports Hall of Fame of New Jersey and International Sports Hall of Fame.

Following his competitive career, he founded the Peter Westbrook Foundation, a non-profit organisation that helped develop fencing athletes from underdeveloped communities in New York City. His programme has produced numerous nationally and internationally ranked athletes, including Olympians Akhi Spencer-El, Ibtihaj Muhammad, Daryl Homer, Curtis McDowald, Khalil Thompson and Lauren Scruggs. Scruggs most recently won two medals at the Paris 2024 Olympic Games.

USA Fencing Chair of the Board of Directors Damien Leffebvre said that Westbrook was “one of the most influential figures in the history of American Fencing. You cannot tell our history without Peter’s on-strip accomplishments, nor can you tell them without his contributions via his foundation.”

Westbrook published a personal memoir in 1997, titled “Harnessing Anger: The Way of an American Fencer,” which was the story of his childhood and how his experiences influenced his success as an Olympic fencer and was inspirational in the founding of his Foundation.

We express our sincerest condolences to the bereaved families and federations of the deceased.

A seminar for the referees designated for the Olympic Games took place in Athens (GRE) on the 1st and 2nd of June 2024.

1.3 — ANTIDOPING

1.3.1 — CONTROLS



Antidoping measures were continued throughout the period and 1 case of doping occurred in competitions organised by the FIE.

In-competition tests: 349 urine tests collected.

Out-of-competition tests: Out of the 98 successfully completed tests, 90 collected urine samples only and 8 collected urine + blood serum samples.

1.3.2 — CLEAN SPORT EDUCATION



In cooperation with the International Testing Agency, the FIE provided 7 Clean Sport webinars in 2024.

a) Dedicated webinars

2 one-hour, interactive anti-doping webinars available to all athletes, coaches, and officials, prior to the Junior and Cadet World Championships and prior to the Olympic Games.

The webinars took place respectively:

on March 19, 2024 (total number of participants: 15)

on June 14, 2024 (total number of participants: 17)

The programmes were presented in English, French and Spanish and covered key clean-sport topics including prohibited substances, medications and supplements and therapeutic-use exemptions (TUEs).

The webinars were presented by the ITA, Jeremy Summers, President of the FIE Medical Commission and Dr Sabrina Halaimia, Member of the FIE Medical Commission. Attendees received an official certificate of participation as well as a PDF of the presentation and links for useful related resources.

b) Series of webinars

5 multi-language webinars addressing anti-doping and Clean Sport principles, information and practices for athletes, coaches and federations.

These Clean Sport webinars were part of the FIE educational programmes, and all FIE athletes and coaches have been highly encouraged to participate in all sessions; for those who attended, a certificate of completion was awarded.

The programmes, presented in English with simultaneous interpreting in Arabic, Spanish, French, Russian and Chinese, included the following topics at the following dates and times:

1.Introduction to anti-doping

Overview of the system, rights and responsibilities, ADRVs

Date and CEST Time: Thursday 26 September 14:00-15:00

2.The Doping Control Process

Includes testing procedures (urine and blood) and ABP

Date and CEST Time: Thursday 3 October 14:00-15:00

3.Medications, Supplements, Prohibited List and TUEs

Includes the Principle of Strict Liability

Date and CEST Time: Thursday 10 October 14:00-15:00

4.Values, Consequences, and Reporting

Includes decision-making and athlete testimonials

Date and CEST Time: Thursday 17 October 14:00-15:00

5.Out-of-Competition Testing

Includes requirements of RTP/TP, whereabouts, use of ADAMS

Date and CEST Time: Thursday 24 October 14:00-15:00

As part of the FIE anti-doping Clean Sport programme, an educational stand provided information about Clean Sport principles and fencing for athletes and coaches during the Junior and Cadet World Championships in Riyadh (KSA). Interactive games were provided along with printed and online resources and gifts to encourage participants to learn about this important area of sports. The stand was staffed by members of the Saudi National Anti-Doping Organisation, under the leadership of Mr. Ali Alateeq, NADO Public Relations and Awareness Director. Prior to the Championships, the NADO also gave a lecture to the Saudi national team on this topic.

1.4 MEDIA

1.4.1 FIE MEDIA REPORT 2024



In 2024, the FIE continued to expand its global promotion through its multiple media platforms, including its official website, social media matrix, online magazine, and television broadcasts. On the social media front, in addition to its established platforms such as Instagram, Facebook, Twitter/X, YouTube, and LinkedIn, the FIE launched a new TikTok account and revived its long-inactive Weibo account. Capitalising on the opportunities presented by iconic events such as the Paris 2024 Olympic Games, Grand Prix events, and the Junior & Cadet World Championships, the FIE CMTV Dept significantly increased content output, enhanced content quality, and actively engaged with key stakeholders, including the IOC and the LOCs. These efforts yielded substantial reporting achievements and ensured sustained growth across its digital channels.

In terms of television broadcasting, leveraging the influence of the Paris 2024, the FIE continued to drive growth in its global audience and media exposure through collaborations with Eurosport, OBS/Olympic Channel, and partnerships with rights holders worldwide.

1.4.2 — DIGITAL CHANNELS

2024 marked an Olympic year centred around the Olympics. Events such as the Junior & Cadet World Championships (Riyadh), Grand Prix events, Senior World Cup events and Zonal Championships were successfully held, with the Olympic fencing competition at the Grand Palais emerging as one of the most discussed and vibrant events throughout the Games. By focusing on the Olympic year theme and adopting "Road To Paris" as the central narrative, the FIE CMTV Dept leveraged the full annual competition schedule to maintain a robust growth across all digital channels. In terms of non-competitive content, the FIE covered and published materials for the annual World Fencing Day, Fencing for the Planet and the traditional Education Programme, generating positive impact in the digital sphere.

The FIE's on-site photographers, Augusto Bizzi and his team, captured the Paris 2024 Games, all World Championships (Junior & Cadet, Veteran), all Grand Prix events, all Senior World Cups, all Zonal Championships, and the year-end Congress. Since the start of the new season in October, the coverage of the Senior World Cup photos has expanded, shifting from providing images only after the individual semifinals and team bronze medal matches to now including photos of all DE bouts.

The FIE's on-site video production team (ICARUS) covered the **Junior & Cadet World Championships** and, for the first time, conducted on-site video filming at Zonal Championships (Europe, Pan America, Asia). Additionally, the team contributed to the production of pre-Olympic preview series and post-event interviews with medallists. Furthermore, the FIE engaged another video production company, Sunset & Vine, to create promotional videos for the Olympic fencing competitions.

Since the start of this GP season, FIE has engaged QTV to provide clipping services. During each GP event's TV broadcast phase (starting from the semifinals), QTV delivers real-time streaming clips and publishing services to enrich the video content on social media. This service ensures the production of at least 15 short videos per GP event.

Live streaming was provided for all direct elimination stages of Grand Prix events, the **Junior & Cadet World Championships** and the **Veteran World Championships**. For Senior World Cups organised by LOCs, live streaming was made available on the FIE website whenever the signal was accessible in a timely manner.

Below are some key facts:

Website

- In 2024, the **FIE website's** news section continued with the content plan, focusing on event and initiative reports, as well as other news such as webinars, obituaries, job postings, etc. Prior to the Olympics, the **"Ones To Watch"** series was also published.
- The FIE website received 9.8 million page views, a decrease of 10% (compared to 10.9 million in 2023). Engagements reached 9.1 million, with 3.1 million sessions. The total number of visitors increased by 17%, reaching 1.09 million (compared to 935K in 2023), including 1.08 million new users, a growth of 19% (compared to 907K in 2023).
- The top countries/regions with the highest number of new users were: United States (166K), Hong Kong - China (100K), France (93K), South Korea (64K), and the United Kingdom (64K). The rankings for active users were the same as the new user statistics.

Instagram

- In 2024, the **FIE Instagram account** experienced 49.5 million impressions and 2.7 million engagements, an increase of 124% and 84.7% respectively. With 22.7K new users added, an increase of 105%. The total amount reached 131.7K by the end of 2024.

Facebook

- In 2024, the **FIE Facebook account** received 32.7 million impressions, an increase of 12.8% compared with 2023. The engagements reached 2 million. The number of followers reached 163,9K, with 10.6K new followers (77% increase) added.

Twitter X

- In 2024, the **FIE Twitter X account** received 3.7 million impressions, a 19.6% decrease compared to 2023. Engagements reached 201K. The number of followers grew to 25.5K, with 1.6K new followers added.

YouTube

- In 2024, the **FIE YouTube channel** experienced 3 million views, 28% less than 2023. The watch time was 305K hours, a 40% decrease compared to 2023. The new subscribers were 8.5K, almost the same in growth rate compared to 2023. The video views increased 53% to 918K, the 2 million live views were 44% less than the 2023. This is due to the fact that the fencing events at the 2024 Olympic Games, unlike the 2023 World Championships, were not available on YouTube. The subscriptions reached 101K by the end of 2024.

LinkedIn

- In 2024, the **FIE LinkedIn** impressions and engagements rose to 57K and 3.4K, reflecting increases of 88.3% and 50.2%, respectively. The number of followers grew by 21.4%, reaching a total of 3.9K.

TikTok

- **The FIE TikTok account** was registered and launched in June 2024 to engage its Gen Z audience. Due to time and resource constraints, the current operation primarily involves synchronising content from Instagram. As TikTok is a key platform in the IOC's social media evaluation for Paris 2024, CMTV Department registered and verified the account prior to the Games and aim to leverage the Olympics' influence to kickstart the platform's growth.
- In the year of 2024 (since June), the account has achieved 61K impressions, 5.5K engagements and 1.3K net followers increase.
- Given that TikTok content has its own unique characteristics and patterns, future operations may consider creating exclusive content and designating a dedicated team for its management.

Weibo

- The **FIE Weibo account** has remained inactive since September 2017. As Weibo data is a part of the IOC's social media evaluation for Paris 2024, CMTV Department regained access to the account in June 2024 and resumed operations. The account began publishing content in June, one month before the Paris Olympic Games countdown.
- The primary content includes: 1) Synchronising posts from the English-language social media platforms. 2) Reposting relevant fencing content from other Weibo users. 3) Localising FIE's official graphic templates and publishing Olympic-related updates in Chinese during the Games.
- As of now, the Weibo account has a total of 31,330 followers (including previously accumulated followers). The 2024 figures show approximately 5.9M impressions and 94 000 engagements.

- Following the start of the new season, the Weibo account continues to operate, focusing primarily on reporting results from events like the Veteran Championships, Grand Prix and Senior World Cup, as well as covering other key FIE events and initiatives like World Fencing Day.

About the Paris 2024 Olympic Games

- The FIE official website garnered approximately 1.34 million impressions, 1.26 million engagements, and 315,000 new users. Compared to the total annual data from the previous Olympic Games (which only provided full-year data, not specific event data), the 2024 Olympic year saw 9.8 million impressions, a 63% increase from Tokyo's 6 million impressions. Sessions reached 3.1 million, a 55% increase from Tokyo's 2 million. The 1.1 million new users remained largely consistent with Tokyo.
- On social media, Instagram recorded 18.3 million impressions (a 55% increase from Tokyo's 11.8 million), 1.05 million engagements and 5,200 net new followers (Tokyo data unavailable). Facebook achieved 10.1 million impressions (a 60% decrease from Tokyo's 25.3 million), 636,000 engagements (a 66% decrease from Tokyo's 1.9 million), and 15,000 net new followers. Twitter X had 2.1 million impressions, 128,000 engagements and 1,200 net new followers. YouTube saw 343,000 video views, 16.5K hours watched and 2,000 new subscribers. Due to the Olympic video copyright restrictions, no event-related videos were posted on the YouTube channel during the competition period; the content here only includes pre- and post-Olympic materials not featuring FOP footage. Similarly, TikTok, constrained by Olympic video copyright, garnered 32,000 post views and 3,000 engagements for Olympic-related content. The Weibo platform, relaunched after seven years, achieved approximately 7.6 million impressions and 93,600 engagements.
- Overall, across all FIE digital media platforms, the total impressions during the Paris Olympic period (including content from the pre-Olympic countdown and post-event summary) reached approximately 40.5 million, with a total of around 3.2 million engagements.
- According to data provided by the IOC, the top five territories with the highest viewership for fencing live streams on digital media platforms during the Olympics were China, USA, Brazil, France and Germany. The top five territories with the highest internet searches were France, USA, Italy, China and Japan. For page views on most popular websites, the top five territories were USA, France, China, South Korea and Italy. In terms of global social media conversations (posts + engagements), fencing reached 12.42M, surpassing the median of 12.02M for all sports, the most discussed events were M Team Sabre, W Team Sabre, and M Individual Sabre.
- Despite the constraints and restrictions regarding videos in relation to the Games, the FIE promoted fencing before the Olympic Games, with many videos such as:

One month to go

Young athletes qualify for Paris

Overall, the FIE digital media matrix experienced robust growth in 2024, largely driven by the momentum of the Olympic Games. Instagram, Facebook, the website and LinkedIn all saw substantial increases, while newly registered or revived platforms like TikTok and Weibo are in the early stages of development. YouTube experienced a predictable decline in data due to Olympic video copyright restrictions, and Twitter X data showed a downturn. Instagram and Facebook remain the two standout platforms for the FIE.

1.4.3 — DIGITAL MAGAZINE – ESCRIME XXI



In 2024, the FIE returned to a regular cycle of three regular issues of *Escrime XXI* per year in addition to an *Escrime XXI*: Annual Review edition. One of the issues, published in the Fall, was a special “Paris 2024” review issue dedicated to the Olympic Games, which can be found [here](#).

All were published in digital format and are available on the FIE.org website in “flipbook” and downloadable PDF formats.

U.S.-based Manna Creations began working with the FIE in 2023 as the new agency of record producing the digital issues of *Escrime XXI*, which resulted in more timely production of the magazine at a significantly lower cost than the previous supplier.

1.4.4 — OFFICIAL 2024 PRESS RELEASES, NEWS STORIES AND MEDIA RELATIONS

In 2024, the FIE significantly increased its ability to communicate with the media by engaging with a media relations contact database management system (www.ConstantContact.com) combined with a professional media research and analysis service (www.CriticalMention.com). This enabled to double the media contact lists to nearly 6,000 press contacts and making it dynamic (meaning it automatically and regularly adds and updates media contacts and listings worldwide). With these services, CMTV can also now easily track the metrics of press release performance worldwide as well as retrieve regular reports and links to global press coverage. As a result, we began generating monthly reports on media coverage.

The FIE published nearly 90 press releases in 2024, most of which were also distributed via the platform referenced above; this included a total of nearly 200,000 emails sent to the worldwide press community. Again, as in 2023, we achieved significantly higher than industry standard “open rates” of confirmations that the press is reading our communication. These results included the busiest period of the year, which were during the Paris 2024 Olympic Games. While there are multiple ways to search media coverage resulting in diverse metrics, it is clear that fencing and the FIE received tens of thousands of press/media mentions and more than 189 million exposures throughout the year worldwide, resulting in a total global audience over more than one billion and with a corresponding publicity value of more than \$20 million (this is a standard media relations industry calculation that represents the cost it would be to advertise for that specific time, programme, and/or platform multiplied by the number of people who viewed the media mention/Audience value).

1.4.5 — TELEVISION

Grand Prix Events (* for the Grand Prix are presented below the metrics of the “2023-2024 season” that included Orleans GP in Dec 2023 but not the Orleans GP in Dec 2024)

- The rightsholders include the Olympic Channel, Eurosport and PCCW.
- FIE Grand Prix broadcasting accumulated an audience of 9.97M million viewers, a 56% decrease compared to the last edition. The top five markets by cumulative audiences are: France (6.57 million), Hungary (1.72 million), Pan-Global (0.51 million), Italy (0.35 million) and Germany (0.11 million). The top 3 GP events by event impressions are: 115 channels across 54 markets provided altogether nearly 1,430 hours of coverage of the FIE Grand Prix 2023/24. FIE’s YouTube channel aired the most hours (433 hours; 30%). On Linear TV, Eurosport 2 CZ provided the most coverage, with 175 hours of broadcast (12%).
- 23/24 Grand Prix events received 337.2 million impressions, a 97% increase compared to the last edition. The top 3 events in terms of Event Impressions by Matchday are: Doha GP (21%), Washington DC GP (15%) and Tunis GP (14%). The top 5 territories in terms of event impressions are: Tunisia (22 million), Pan-MENA (21.36 million), Hungary (18.65million), Pan-Asia (13.32 million) and Germany (12.47 million).

IOC Data Collection from Paris 2024

The IOC collected comprehensive data from the Paris 2024 Olympic Games about all visibility and performance of all sports in the media, as carried out in previous Games. This is based on the IOC’s Olympic Agenda 2020 to “move from a sport-based to an event-based programme”, and reviewed television, social media, press coverage and ticketing. Fifteen different points of analysis were reviewed; in some cases, the coverage was global while in others it was limited to [up to] 30, 50 or 80 global territories.

Fencing at the Olympic Games performed close to the median of all indicators in 11 of the 15 categories as compared with all sports, placing it overall in the “middle third”. This included television coverage, website page views (including page views on “most popular” websites by region), social media sharing and conversations, number of press articles and the number of tickets sold. As a “favourite sport among the general public and youth sport”, fencing overall was close to the median.

Fencing exceeded the median in some areas, including total number of TV viewer hours, with men’s epee, men’s team foil, women’s team foil and women’s team sabre being the highest. Television viewer hours were the highest in countries where fencing is typically strongest, including France, Italy (Europe), Japan, Korea, China (Asia) and USA and Brazil (Americas) being the strongest overall by region.

A few areas fell slightly below the median (but above the minimum) including digital viewership, total number of internet searches and IF-owned social media performance. Instagram and TikTok were the strongest performers for the FIE. Again, by region, internet searches by region were strongest in the countries named in the previous paragraph, as well as in Egypt and Morocco for Africa.

Overall number of press articles covering fencing at Paris 2024 was close to the median of all sports, with men’s individual epee standing out as the highest performing event by press coverage. Strongest coverage by regions and countries included France and Italy, Korea and Japan, USA and Canada, and Egypt.

At the Olympic Games, the Grand Palais proved to be an outstanding venue for ticket sales, achieving a 99% sell-through rate for the overall tickets available.

Eurosport

- In the 2023-2024 season, on **Eurosport**, FIE events featured 45-minute highlights for Grand Prix events (consistent with the previous season) and 12 hours of live coverage for the Basel European Championships (no Senior World Championships) across Eurosport channels, including Eurosport 1, Eurosport 2 and Eurosport Asia.
- The coverage duration for Grand Prix is 36 hours, decreased by 38% due to the hours of replay, while the European Championships saw 114 hours of coverage, significantly higher than the previous season’s Senior World Championships (70 hours).
- In terms of TV campaign, 155 TV spots recorded 55.3 million impacts (vs. 38.9M in 2023), reaching 16.6 million unique viewers (vs. 12.9M in 2023).

1.4.6 CHALLENGES & CHANGES

As an Olympic year, 2024 presented a significant opportunity for the FIE to expand its media influence across various channels. To enrich media content, the FIE added additional video productions alongside regular content. Notably, interactions with renowned artist (former fencer Jackson Wang) generated substantial traffic, 1 million impressions, 38K engagements, opening doors for future collaborations.

To capitalise on the Olympic momentum and further promote the sport of fencing, the 2024 World Fencing Day activities exceeded expectations both in preparation and social media performance on the event day, setting a benchmark for future initiatives.

As the new season begins, the FIE has raised its standards for both the quantity and quality of content production. In photography, there is an increased demand for World Cup photos to ensure more content can be published. In video production, to create more creative pieces targeting the Gen Z audience, a bidding system has been introduced to explore more possibilities. In branding, alongside continuing the standardised approach for Grand Prix events, there is stricter oversight of Senior World Cup designs, with FIE branding assets now recommended and shared with LOCs for reference. For event coverage, communication with LOCs remain vital to ensure richer content. The reporting for GP and Senior World Cup events will be more detailed and enriched, with a stronger focus on co-creation with LOCs.

1.7 — WORLD FENCING DAY 2024



The **2024 World Fencing Day** event took place on September 14, 2024, with the theme "We Welcome the World to Fencing." To further enhance the event's impact and encourage greater participation, the CMTV department created a press kit, including branding assets for participation, and shared it publicly with all member federations and stakeholders.

We received video greetings from over fifty athletes worldwide, which were edited into three official videos. This year's event saw broader participation and a higher volume of content published compared to last year. In addition to web news, the FIE's social media content showed significant growth. 2.1 TRAINING CAMPS FOR ATHLETES

RIYADH

Before the Junior and Cadet World Championships, an FIE training camp took place at the same place as the competition Venue. Each weapon started training 6 days before the individual competition, with 2 training sessions: 3 hours in the morning and 3 hours in the afternoon. 20 fencers from around the world were invited:

- 5 from Asia-Oceania
- 5 from Europe
- 5 from Pan-America
- 5 from Africa

The training venue had 10 designated pistes exclusively for the FIE camp and had medical service available on site for any emergency or need from the athletes or coaches. Each weapon trained separately, with the following coaches:

Rita Abou Jaoude (LBN), foil,
Alexandros Emmanouilidis (CYP) epee,
Andrew Fischl (USA) sabre.

The training was specially designed by each coach according to the needs from the group: it included a general group warm up, individual lessons, theoretical and tactical explanations, competition simulation, footwork, coordination activities, among others, everything specially designed for each weapon. The day before competition, video analysis was set, and recreational activities pre-competition were carried out.

All expenses were covered by FIE: flights, transport, visas expenses, individual competition entry fee, hotel, meals, and extra 50€ pocket money to each of the fencers.

Beside fencing, every group took different experiences outside the fencing hall, sharing cultures and showing friendship and respect within each other, at every moment.

Azerbaijan had a place for men's sabre but cancelled at the last minute, and Asia-Oceania had an extra place that was not allocated to any country.

For this camp financial aid was received from a special programme from IOC that provided financial aid for training camps to countries with less than 50 Olympic participants on the last Olympic Games. This special aid was allocated to 12 NOCs of fencers and coaches and the Olympic Solidarity reimbursed to the FIE the corresponding amount.

2.2 Oceania Fencing Master Academy (OFMA)

Oceania Fencing Confederation (OFC) Coaching Commission

The Coaching Commission met online monthly during 2024 to plan and progress various OFMA projects and to administer the operational activities of OFMA.

A 2024 Coach Education Plan was developed to assist the education and training of Level 1 and aspirant Level 2 Coaches in Epee.

Planning for an online Level 2 Sabre Coaching Course in 2025 is also in progress with our partners, Global Fencing Masters.

OFMA Coach Education

The Regional Development Officer started the face-to-face coaching assessments for the Online Coaching Level One Group OFMA GFM Epee Course conducted in 2023. These assessments continued throughout 2024 for students across New Zealand and Australia as the OFC Coach Commission worked its way through various locations in Oceania.

OFMA continued collaboration with Global Fencing Masters (GFM) to advertise and conduct an online Level 2 Epee Course as a follow up to the 2023 online Epee Course. Using a web-based learning platform, a phone app and Zoom technology, the Course was presented over four months from March to June to 20 Coaches from Australia, New Zealand, Guam and Papua New Guinea.

The Level 2 Course concentrated on individual coaching, where the coach learns to work one on one with the athlete, performance fencing rather than group coaching that introduces new fencers to the sport.

The OFC partnered with Sydney International Fencing Camp (SIFC) in January 2025 to provide additional practical learning and offer the ability to finalise coaches Level 2 Epee coaching accreditation in addition to the offer of Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) assessments.

The OCPD also travelled to Fiji and Papua New Guinea in March to continue coaching and development work. Coaching Commission members in New Zealand also conducted content revision and assessments of Level 1 Epee coaches at different locations.

2.3 BUDAPEST ACADEMY



During 2024, the FIE Budapest Coaching Academy continued to form fencing coaches on a 3-month course specific for each weapon. The Academy strategy, as decided in 2016, is to open an education centre for coaches, where coaches from all over the world could come to learn and improve their level, so they can return home updated and with a high level of knowledge.

During 2024, three 3-month courses were organised:

Sabre: from January 29th to April 19th, 2024. For this initial course there were 9 candidates accepted (3 from Europe, 2 from America and 4 from Asia-Oceania). 3 women took part in this course. All students successfully passed.

Epee: from April 29th to July 19th, 2024, there were 8 candidates accepted (3 from Europe, 4 from Asia-Oceania and 1 from Pan-America). 2 women took part in this course. All students successfully passed.

Foil: from July 29th to October 18th, 2024. There were 8 applications accepted (3 from Europe, 4 from Asia-Oceania and 1 from Pan-American). 1 woman took part in this course. All students successfully passed.

The training sessions were scheduled from Monday to Friday, 6 hours per day, for 12 weeks.

Daily course schedule (Weeks 1-8)

- 09.00-09.45: General warm up, fencing specific warm up, games.
- 10.00-10.45: Exercises for footwork development.
- 11.00-12.30: Weapon-specific coaching with weapon specialist coach.
- 15.00-17.00: Weapon-specific coaching - ongoing development.



Daily course schedule (Weeks 9-12)

- Preparing for practical exam.
- Construction of the exam-lesson. Practicing, overseen by mentor coach.
- Exams

The Hungarian University of Sport Science joined the programme and provided theory lessons on sport physiology, training theory, sport pedagogy, sport psychology and biomechanics, all in different modules given by specialised instructors and researchers from the University, divided on a 16-hour long class time. As part of this agreement, the University acknowledges the Academy training and awards internationally recognized Level 2 diplomas to those Academy students who pass the final exam.

At the end of the programme, both practical and theoretical exams were done to demonstrate and prove learned knowledge.

Mr. Zoltan BERNAT was hired and responsible for the everyday situations during the academy, taking care of any special request or issue that might rise.

The selected coaches to provide the specific fencing training were:

Sabre: Maître Zsolt NEMCSIK

Epee: Maître György FELLETÁR

Foil: Maître Zoltan BERNAT

- 23 over 25 students were experienced coaches, with more than 5 years' experience before getting into the Academy.
- All graduate students were encouraged to return to their home countries to pass their knowledge and to improve fencing in their own countries.

Local authorities of Budapest helped to rent ideal facilities, where coaches could learn and practice under the best conditions. Full accommodation and catering were provided to the students during all their course.

All participants stayed on the Benczúr Hotel, in twin rooms, sharing by same gender or individual rooms if there was not another candidate of the same gender. All meals were served at the hotel. The hotel is located at a walking distance from the training venue.

Transportation to the university for theoretical courses were made by public transport covered by each participant.

A special aid for participants of 300 CHF was allocated to cover part of their transport expenses when requested by participants.

2.4.1 FENCING EQUIPMENT REPAIR COURSE



An [equipment repair course in Johannesburg](#), South Africa took place from September 23 – 27. The group comprised 8 students: 2 each from Kenya, Angola, Togo, and 1 each from Mauritius and South Africa.

The group was particularly attentive and eager to learn. They were very active in the many practical exercises and provided very satisfactory and promising results.

After explanations about how weapons work and particularities of their electrical circuitry, were discussed different possible failures, how to locate problems and how to fix them.

Each trainee was able to completely dismantle a foil and an epee and carry out the reassembly including gluing and installing new wires.

The last course was devoted to raising awareness of competition weapons control organisation and piste installation verification. In particular, the students were shown how to carry out this verification using a basic tester and DIY tools. This part of the training was particularly appreciated by the two Angolan students in view of the organisation of the next African Junior and Cadet Championships.

The working environment of the Academy fencing school made it possible to carry out this internship in the best conditions.

2.6 EQUIPMENT AID

The budget for 2024 amounted to 600 000 CHF. The FIE allocated 6000 CHF to each NF, for a total of 103 NFs. All fencing material is FIE homologated for competition. The FIE received orders for Absolute Fencing, Allstar, Artos, Favero, Fencing Vision, Leon Paul, PBT, Rana Kilit and Uhlmann.

The FIE requested the Presidents of Confederation to send a list of 25 countries that will receive desirable equipment. They were given 4 options of fencing equipment package (pistes, blades, scoring machines and clothing). Every country also had the option to choose equipment from one or more suppliers and mixed items as long as all were FIE approved and within the budget.

All the orders were approved by the Sport Director after the request from NFs and before buying and shipping.

The programme started in February with the invitation to confederations and in April the confirmation of the federations and their wishing lists were mostly received. During May, the orders were submitted to manufacturers for preparation and in July, 84 orders were confirmed and shipped or in process of delivery.

PAN AMERICAN CADET AND JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS 2024

This important event in the city of Rio de Janeiro, Brazil, from 22 to 27 February 2024, in the Arena Carioca 1 at the Olympic Park, with many competitors who gave their best to be crowned as Pan American Cadet and Junior Champions.

PAN AMERICAN SENIOR CHAMPIONSHIP 2024

The Pan American Senior Championships 2024 took place in the city of Lima, Peru, from 25 to 30 June 2024. The competition was carried out in the velodrome of the VIDENA high performance centre. This tournament brought together the best fencers of the continent, some of them already qualified for the Paris 2024 Olympics.

PANAMERICAN CHILDREN'S AND VETERANS' CHAMPIONSHIPS 2024.

From 14 to 19 August 2024, the Pan American Children and Veterans Championship was held in Escazú, Costa Rica. Once again, this event brought together a considerable number of children and veterans who, accompanied by their families and friends, enjoyed this joyful competition, which sees an increase in the number of participants at each edition.

2024 COACHES COURSES

From 10 to 20 December 2024, the FIE Pan-American Foil Coaching Course was held in the city of San Salvador, El Salvador, carried out by master Petru Kuki. With a total of 35 coaches from 25 national federations, different topics were developed for the training of national coaches.

CPE 2024 ELECTIVE CONGRESS

The elective congress of the CPE took place in the city of Tashkent, Uzbekistan, unanimously electing by acclamation Mr. Vitaly Logvin as president for the period 2024 - 2028. The following members were elected as vice-presidents: Mr. Yann Bernard (CAN) as 1st vice-president, Mr. Ángel Garcia (PER) as 2nd vice-president and Ms. Ana Irene Delgado (PAN) as 3rd vice-president. The following Members of the executive committee were elected: Mr. Otto Balderramos (GUA), Mr. Alhjadis Bandera (CUB) and Ms. Barbara Blumel (CHI). Mr. William Genet (NCA) was ratified as Secretary General and Ms. Melissa Alvarenga (ESA) as Executive secretary. The elective assembly was attended by Mr. Emmanuel Katsiadakis, FIE Interim President.

EXTRAORDINARY ACTIVITIES

During the Pan American Children's and Veterans' Championships and the Junior Epee World Cup, both held in Costa Rica, a campaign to obtain the ecological blue flag for special events was developed, which meant a collaboration between all participants to adopt measures of cleanliness, recycling and care of the environment. Both events qualified for the approval and in a historical way, the Panamerican Confederation obtained these certifications in an official FIE event.

2.10.4 — OCEANIA FENCING CONFEDERATION (OFC)



DEVELOPING NEW FEDERATIONS IN THE PACIFIC

- The OFC currently comprises six full members—American Samoa, Australia, Guam, New Zealand, Papua New Guinea, and Samoa—and two associate members, Tahiti and New Caledonia.
- The OFC has continued its support of the Fiji Fencing Federation by including its coaches in training programmes. In 2024, the Regional Development Officer (RDO) visited Fiji to advance fencing development efforts.

DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES IN 2024

- The OFC Annual General Meeting was held online in August.
- Six OFC Board meetings were conducted virtually throughout the year.
- OFC administration was managed through email, online meetings and phone calls, with regular coordination between the OFC President, Secretary-General, Regional Development Officer (RDO)/OFMA Coaching Programme Director and Secretary/Finance Officer.
- The OFC Coaching Commission met online seven times.
- The OFC partnered with the Oceania Fencing Master's Academy (OFMA) and Global Fencing Masters (GFM) to deliver the GFM Level 2 Online Epee Course, following the success of the Level 1 course. Twenty students from across Oceania participated, with 17 achieving OFMA Level 2 accreditation in January 2025.
- The OFC is collaborating with the Sydney International Fencing Camp (SIFC) in January 2025 for an eight-day coaching course and final assessments for the GFM Level 2 Epee participants.
- The OFC provided funding support for referee development courses in Sydney, Australia, and Christchurch, New Zealand.

REGIONAL DEVELOPMENT OFFICER REPORT 2024 FIJI

Leon Thomas, the OFC Regional Development Officer (RDO), visited Fiji from March 10–27 to assist with coaching programmes and meet with the Fiji Sports Council to discuss Fiji Fencing's progress towards recognition by FASAHOC. Opportunities for involvement in Inter- Uni Sport and the identification of local coaching resources were explored.

Key activities completed:

- Seven introductory fencing sessions at ISS with 122 participants (50 male, 72 female).
- Two fencing classes at ISS with up to 9 students (7 male, 2 female).
- Three teacher training classes at ISS with up to 8 participants (4 male, 4 female).
- Ongoing training of two ISS coaches.
- Assessment of Apisalome Dumuyawa as a Level 1 Foil Group Coach.
- Meetings with Fiji sports officials, including Peter Masey (Fiji Sports Council) and Katerina Toga (Fiji National University).
- During his visit, the RDO also represented the OFC at the ONOC/OSFO Conference.

REGIONAL DEVELOPMENT OFFICER REPORT 2024 PAPUA NEW GUINEA (PNG)

The RDO visited PNG from May 21–30, meeting with the FPNG President and the PNG Olympic Committee Secretary-General, Desmond Kaviagu, to discuss development plans and funding opportunities.

Key activities completed:

- Try sessions and beginner courses for fencers and coaches.
- Introduction to Epee coaching and equipment use.
- Training in electric Epee fencing.
- In October 2025, the RDO returned to PNG to further support development efforts.

Additional activities included:

- Guidance on the ongoing beginner programme, including coach support.
- Level 1 Foil Group Course for new coaches.
- Level 1 Epee individual instruction for Keina Laka, Andrew Molen, and Reeves Papaol.
- Meetings with PNG Olympic Committee representatives.
- Assistance with implementing and expanding the Fencing PNG Development Plan.
- Inventory assessment of new and existing equipment for future planning.

OCEANIA CHAMPIONSHIPS

Oceania Junior Championships:

Held in Melbourne, Australia (February 1–4, 2024), attended by Andrea Chaplin (Secretary-General), Leon Thomas (OFC RDO/OC PD), and referee Michael Claydon (NZL).

Oceania Veteran's Championships:

Hosted in Feilding, New Zealand, alongside the NZL North Island Championships (June 1–3, 2025). OFC representatives included David Elder and Leon Thomas, with Clayton Ferguson (AUS) appointed as the referee.

Fencers from New Zealand and Australia participated, though attendance from other member federations was limited due to prohibitive travel costs. The OFC continues to support aspiring international referees by funding their participation in these events.

PARTICIPATION IN FIE EVENTS AND ACTIVITIES

- OFC President Helen Smith and RDO Leon Thomas attended the OSFO and ONOC Annual General Assemblies in Nadi, Fiji (March 23–27), engaging in discussions critical to fencing development in Oceania.
- Oceania fencers participated in various international events, including the World and Asian Junior, Cadet, Senior, and Veteran Championships.
- Despite an invitation for New Zealand to participate in the 2024 FIE Training Camps in Riyadh, KSA, no Oceania fencers attended.
- OFC President Helen Smith, accompanied by Secretary-General Andrea Chaplin, attended the World Junior & Cadet Championships in Riyadh (April 15–20), fostering international relationships for future OFC succession planning.
- Helen Smith represented OFC at the Asia-Oceania Olympic Qualification Tournament in Fujairah, UAE (April 27–28). Nine athletes from AUS and NZL competed, with Veronika Vassileva (AUS) earning a bronze medal in Women's Sabre. The OFC provided each athlete with an AUD 1,000 grant for participation.
- Helen Smith also attended the 2024 Paris Olympics from 25 July to 6 August where she was privileged to attend the Opening Ceremony and the nine days of the Fencing events. The Grand Palais proved to be a majestic & atmospheric venue to showcase our sport & the largely French spectators were very knowledgeable & deeply engaged in the action on the pistes.
- Oceania referees officiated at FIE events, including World Cups, Junior World Cups, Satellites, Grand Prix, University Games, and Asian Championships. Two referees successfully obtained FIE B Licences in Kuala Lumpur in 2024.
- The OFC acknowledges the FIE Sports Department's assistance with the 2024 Material Aid Programme, which provided equipment grants to Papua New Guinea, American Samoa, and New Zealand.
- With FIE travel subsidies, five of six Oceania federations were represented at the FIE Congress in Tashkent, Uzbekistan (November 2024) by either a delegate or proxy.

SUPPORT FROM THE FIE

- The OFC is deeply grateful for the administrative and technical support provided by the FIE Interim President, CEO, and staff.
- We hope that funding for the Regional Development Officer position, previously included in the FIE budgets, will be reinstated to sustain essential OFC development initiatives.

The 2024 Refereeing Exams were organised by the FIE Refereeing Commission in Dakar (Senegal) from 3rd to 6th of October 2024 with 70 participants.

FIE Training Camps

The FIE is traditionally organising Training Camps before the Senior and Junior & Cadet World Championships in all three weapons. Fencers from different African countries participated at each of these camps. Usually 5 African Fencing Federations are sending their athletes to the training camps based on the rotation basis that is applied.

EQUIPMENT Grants

The CAE National Federations applied for and received sets of equipment, organised by the FIE from recognised FIE suppliers with a total value of CHF 6000 (including shipment).

Organisation of African Championships

- The 2024 African Junior & Cadet & U15 Championships were organised in Cairo (Egypt) from 4th to 6th of March.
- 2024 African Seniors Championships were organised in Casablanca (Morocco) from June 6th to 10th

Organisation of the FIE international competitions

In 2024 Fencing federations of Egypt, Tunisia, Algeria, Morocco and Nigeria very successfully organised Senior and Junior World Cups in all three weapons.

2024 Olympic Games

In 2024, 9 African countries qualified 30 fencers for the Olympic Games in Paris: Egypt 16, Algeria 4, Ivory Coast 2, Morocco 2, Tunisia 2, Kenya 1, South Africa 1, Senegal 1 and Niger 1

That is the best achievement of African fencing in the history of Olympic Games which makes us all proud of being part of the African Fencing Confederation.

That achievement was not the only one 2024 Olympic Games success. At the probably most attractive fencing competition in recent times, 2 African fencers won medals:

- **FERJANI Fares** from Tunisia won Men's Sabre Individual Silver Medal
- **ELSAIED Mohamed** from Egypt won Men's Épée Individual Bronze Medal

FIE World Cups, Grand Prix and Satellites

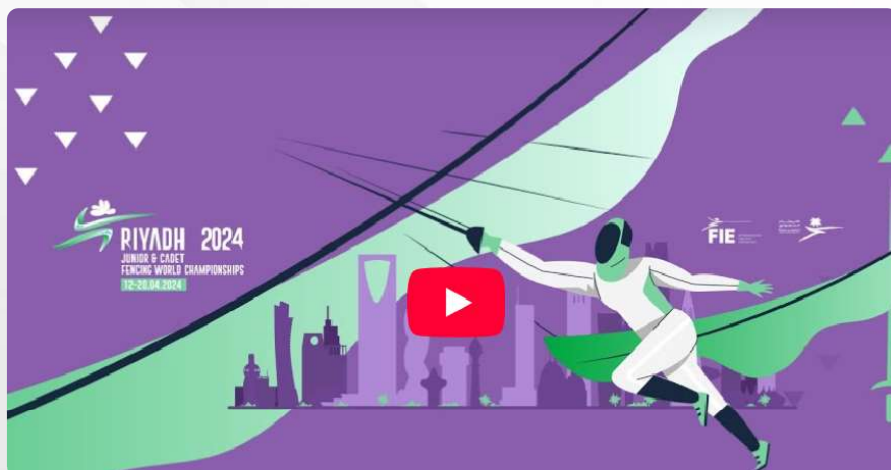
