**FIE Cadet and Junior Sabre World Cup for Women and Men,
Individual and Team, Bogota, Colombia, January 2-4, 2026**



Bogotá, officially Bogotá, Capital District (is the capital of the Republic of Colombia and from the department of Cundinamarca).



It is the third highest capital city in the world (after La Paz and Quito), since it is located at an average of 2625 meters above sea level. It is located in the center of Colombia, in the natural region known as the Bogotá savanna, which is part of the Cundiboyacense Plateau, training located in the Eastern mountain range of the Andes.

The city's airport, El Dorado International Airport, named after the mythical El Dorado, has the largest volume of cargo transported in Latin America and it is the first in South America in number of people.

It is the Colombian city with the highest number of universities (114) and research centers. It boasts a wide range of cultural offerings represented by a large number of museums, theaters and public libraries, which has given it the recognition of the "Athens of South America".

The average temperatures in Bogotá for the month of January are 18° / 12°C

In Colombia, the common voltage is 110 V. The frequency is 60 Hz. The plugs and sockets are type A/B.

Category: "A" – Cadet and Junior World Cup

Date: January 2-4, 2026

Place: Sports Palace", Av José Celestino Mutis #59a-06, Bogotá Colombia.

Formula: In accordance with the FIE Regulations.

Individual test: elimination by groups, direct elimination bracket until the final (cf. o.35-o.41).

Team events: full knockout bracket, which may be incomplete. Eleven places will be contested in the bracket up to 16th place. From 17th place onwards, teams will be seeded in each round of the bracket according to their initial ranking. The top four teams will be placed in the knockout round according to the current FIE official team rankings (see Rule 86); the remaining qualified teams will be placed in the pairs bracket. Unqualified teams will occupy the last places in the bracket and will be drawn by pairs (see Rules 42-47).

Doping: Anti-doping controls will be carried out in accordance with FIE regulations.

Stake: Each national federation can present a maximum of 12 shooters. For individual World Cup tournaments outside of Europe, the host country may enter up to 30 shooters plus as many shooters as are needed to complete the pools.

Participation in the team events is open to all Federations and is limited to one team per weapon and per country.

Registration: The Cup is open to all fencers with a valid license for the 2025-2026 season.

No fencer may participate in an official FIE test if he or she is not at least 13 years old on January 1 of the year of the competition.

Participants in all official FIE junior individual and team events must be under 20 years of age at midnight on December 31 of the year preceding the tournament year (cf. o.80).

Registration of shooters, teams and referees must be done on the FIE website, www.fie.org, respecting the deadlines specified in the FIE regulations (cf. o.54).

Registration fees will be paid at the competition venue starting on the day Thursday, January 2, 2026.

Referees Participating countries must be accompanied by an FIE A and B licensed referee, as indicated below (cf. t.35). Delegations that do not comply with the quota will be penalized with a fine of EUR 1,000.00 per referee.

5-9 shooters, 1 referee

10 or more players, 2 referees

1 team, 1 referee.
