

PAN-AMERICAN CADET AND JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIP 2026

The Colombian Fencing Federation (FCE), together with the Pan American Fencing Confederation (CPE), is pleased to invite the National Federations that are members of the Pan American Fencing Confederation to the 2026 Cadet and Junior Pan American Championship, which will be held according to the following rules:

PLACE : Sports Palace "José Celestino Mutis" Avenue #59a-06, Bogotá, Colombia.

DATE: From February 24 to March 1, 2026

REGISTRATIONS: They must be endorsed by their respective National Federation, and must be registered on the website of the FIE: (www.fie.org) and send the cadet category form provided by the organization to the organizing Federation by email: fcsgrimacol@gmail.com

The registration of fencers, teams and referees must be made on the FIE website, www.fie.org, respecting the deadlines specified in the FIE regulations (cf. o.54).

The registration fee per athlete is \$30.00 USD for each individual competition and \$70.00 USD for the team competition. Information on where to pay the registration fee will be provided.

Registrations must be made in accordance with the FIE Organisation Rules o.55, o.56, o.60. Registrations by mail [electronic: fcsgrimacol@gmail.com](mailto:fcsgrimacol@gmail.com) Attach registration form.

FORMULA: In accordance with the FIE Regulations.

Individual test: group elimination, direct elimination table until the final (cf. o.35-o.41).





Team events: Complete direct elimination bracket, which may be incomplete. Eleven places will be contested in the bracket up to 16th place. From 17th place onwards, teams will be ranked in each round of the bracket according to their initial ranking in the bracket. The top four teams will be placed in the direct elimination round according to the current official FIE team rankings (see o.86); the other qualified teams will be placed in the bracket in pairs. Unqualified teams will occupy the last places in the bracket and will be drawn in pairs (see o.42-o.47).

WEAPONS CHECK: According to the FIE Regulations, the inspection will be carried out in the arena's armory. The inspection will take place the day before the event, according to the program.

MEETINGTECHNIQUE: February 23, 2025, 6:00 PM, Auditorium Hotel Parque 63. Only two delegates per country are allowed.

AWARDS: Prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and two third-place finishes in the individual competition, and 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place in the team competition.

REFEREES: In accordance with the current FIE Competition System Participation of referees (FIE Organisational Rules No. 25):

-  **1 to 4 participating athletes per delegation: 0 referees**
-  **5 to 10 participating athletes per delegation: 1 referee**
-  **10 or more participating athletes per delegation: 2 referees**
-  **1 (one) registered team: 1 referee**
