Participation

0.62 1. For Individual World Cup competitions, each national federation may enter a maximum of 12 fencers. The organising country may enter up to 20 fencers plus the number needed to make up the pools.

Entry

Every competitor is required to be licensed for the 2025/2026 season.

No fencer is allowed to take part in an official event of the FIE unless he or she is at least 13 years old on 1 January in the year of the competition.

Entries of fencers and teams can only be made at the FIE website, www.fie.org, respecting the deadlines specified in the FIE Rules (0.61).

Entry fee

Individual competition: **80 EUR**

The entry fee can also be paid at registration before the start of the competition.

Referee Obligation

The referees are designated by the FIE and delegations will not have to provide any referees.

Formula

Individual competitions – One qualifying round of pools, a preliminary direct elimination table, a main direct elimination table of 64 fencers to qualify for a final by direct elimination.

Doping

Doping control will be done according to FIE rules.

Maximum equipment to be tested:

4 x Epee, 3 x Cabels, 2 x Masks, 2 x Gloves, 2 x Jackets, 2 x Pants, 2 x Plastrons
