DECISIONS OF THE FIE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

Following the meetings and consultations of the Bureau and Executive Committee held in Rio de Janeiro (BRA), please find below and attached the decisions taken:

1. CALENDAR 2026-2027

The FIE Executive Committee has drafted a revised calendar implementing the following recommendations from the athletes and coaches:

- Prioritise double World Cups for Juniors and Seniors whenever possible
- Allocate more preparation time between Zonal Championships and World Championships
- Monitor the organisation of competitions strictly in order to provide equal conditions to athletes all over the world.

The percentage of 25% of competitions per continental zone has been cancelled.

The organising Federations will soon be contacted. They will also be provided with a summary of their organisational obligations and the template of a new reporting system. This new reporting system will cover various areas and angles and will allow the assessment of competitions through practical and objective criteria. Reports will be drafted after each event by FIE Event Managers (in senior competitions) and FIE Supervisors (in Junior and Cadet World Cups).

2. ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

The following modifications were operated: Chapter 2, article 3.1.4 and article 9.3.3. The modifications to article 9.3.3 (revised number of points awarded to Satellite competitions) will come into effect at the beginning of the season 2026-2027.
