a) Senior Women's and Men's Epée

The Australian Federation has just informed us that due to a lack of sponsors, it is obliged to <u>cancel</u> the women's épée and men's épée competitions that were scheduled to take place in Sydney on 24-25 May 2008.

You will find attached the 2008-2009 calendar project. The calendar has not undergone any changes since the 2007-2008 calendar and therefore the same scheduling was used.

During the FIE Executive Committee meeting on 23 November 2007 in Madrid, the Executive Committee chose to examine more in depth the project of completely restructuring the calendar (reducing the number of competitions to 11 per weapon, two-week gaps between the competitions etc).

Consequently, this restructuring has been put off until the calendar of the 2009-2010 season.
