- Article m.25: the participating federations which have not yet submitted the logos of their national clothing to the approval of the Executive Committee, must send them by electronic mail (<u>info@fie.ch</u>) before August 15, 2006. If not, the equipment of the fencer(s) will be declared non-conform.
- 2) **Article o.53**: the entries of athletes and teams are to be made via the FIE website, in accordance with the modes and deadlines laid down in the article o.53 of the Rules of the FIE.
- 3) Entries of officials: the entries of officials are to be made via the FIE website in accordance with the modes and deadlines laid down in the document attached named "Entries to a competition", also posted in the menu "Help" of the FIE web site
- 4) In order to be authorised to participate in the World Championships, national federations must be up-to-date with their payments due to the FIE.
- 5) The entry fees must be paid to the organiser, which can be contacted at the following address: escrime-torino2006.com.
- 5) **Accreditations**: the company Ophardt-Team-Sportevent will be in charge of them. The photos of participating fencers and officials must be sent to Ophardt-Team-Sportevent **before Friday 15 of September 2006** to the following e-mail address: s.lange-derkum@t-online.de.
- one file (photo) for each person
- *jpg or *gif format. Word or PDF files or photo board will not be accepted.
- maximum size of each photo: 100 ko. Zipped files accepted.
- each file should mention the first name, the family name, the function of the person and the nationality (abbreviation):

Example: firstname FAMILYNAME function nationality.jpg

2. Refereeing examinations

The following was proposed at the meeting of the Refereeing Commission, which was held in Hammamet on 8 and 9 July 2006 :

- a) From 2007, the refereeing examinations (1 per year and per zone) will exclusively take place before the Zonal Championships;
- b) The number of candidates will be determined according to candidatures but only 12 candidates per day will sit for the examination.
- c) The candidates to the examinations are selected by the FIE, on the basis of one candidate per country and per weapon, among the list of candidates published on the FIE Internet website, menu \ll Refereeing ».

This list includes the names of candidates, for which:

- the national federation sent to the FIE the form of candidature duly filled in;
- the examination fee was paid.
- d) The results of the refereeing examinations are submitted to the approval of the Refereeing Commission.
