**a) Precisions regarding the national colours**

In order to follow up with several questions raised, we remind you that the back of the fencers' jacket must display only the name and the abbreviation of the nationality of the athlete.

No additional text, logo or drawing are authorised on the back of the jacket (see Publicity Code C) Advertising which is worn or carried, b) Fencing clothing and equipment).

**c) 2005 – 2006 Calendar**

Following several modifications in the attribution of Grand Prix, you will find herewith the 2005-2006 calendar.

The 2006 Junior/Cadet World Championships will take place in Taebaek City (KOR) instead of Jeonju City (KOR).

Due to the organisation of major events, which were not scheduled at the time of the candidacy of Jeonju City, the Korean Fencing Federation is not in a position to offer a large range of hotel rates categories for the rooms of delegations in Jeonju City.

This federation has therefore negotiated and obtained competitive rates for the accommodation in Taebaek City, city deeply involved in the organisation of major sporting events and sport's industry. Taebaek City offers training centres for the athletes and important sporting infrastructures.


