



Summary of the decisions taken by the General Assembly 2009

Belfast (GBR), 4 April 2009

74 national federations were present or represented.

The following items were approved unanimously:

- 1) The Executive Committee's 2008 Annual Report
- 2) The 2007/2008 Financial Report and Accounts Review
- 3) The Auditors' Report
- 4) Approval of the accounts and discharge to the Executive Committee and the auditors
- 5) The modified 2008/2009 budget and 2009/2010 budget
- 6) Ernst and Young's contract has been renewed for one year

7) The following candidatures were accepted:

- 2010 Junior/Cadet World Championships in Baku (AZE)
- 2011 Junior/Cadet World Championships in Kiev (UKR)
- 2011 Senior World Championships: Budapest (HUN), Catania (ITA), Tianjin (CHN) and Varna (BUL)
- There were no candidates for the 2010 and 2011 Veteran World Championships

8) Miscellaneous items

The General Assembly decided to close the office in Paris further to the staff relocating to Lausanne. The Assembly authorises the President to carry out all the actions, proceed with all the legal requirements necessary, go through all the formalities with the French administrative authorities and take over the entirety of the actions carried out in France. The General Assembly decided to give power of attorney and full powers to its President, with the right to delegate to any person of his choice, for the purposes of signing all documents, and to carry out all the necessary formalities to implement the above.
