

List of decisions of the 2008 General Assembly

Acireale (ITA), 5 April 2008

77 national federations were present or represented.

The following items were approved:

- 1) 2007 annual report of the Executive Committee
- 2) Financial report and accounts for 2006/2007
- 3) Report of the auditors
- 4) Approval of the accounts and discharge to the Executive Committee and to the auditors
- 5) Budget for 2008/2009
- 6) Ernst and Young's mandate has been renewed for one year

7) The following World Championships have been awarded:

- 2009 World Junior/cadet Championships to Belfast (GBR)
- 2009 Open World Championships to Antalya (TUR)
- 2009 Veteran World Championships to Moscow (RUS)

The awarding of the 2010 World Junior/Cadet Championships to Novi Sad (SRB) has been postponed pending the completion of the candidature dossier.

Because of high level of costs involved in organising Junior World Championships combined with Cadet World Championships, the national federations asked for a final decision of the Congress regarding the separation of the two competitions. The cadet Championships would thus become continental events organised by the zonal confederations.

8) Congress

The city of Palermo (ITA) was awarded the organisation of the 2009 Congress.

The cities of Sintra (POR) and Bonn (GER) announced their candidature to organise the 2011 Congress.
