### **Referee Examinations in 2011 (dates, locations, and examiners)**

- Second examination for Europe in Bratislava, 16, 17, 18 November 2011.  
Examiners: Salah Ferjani and Claus Janka.
- Refereeing examination for America in Quito, Ecuador, in November 2011.  
Examiners: Derek Cotton and Reiko Nakata.
- Third refereeing examination for Asia, in Doha (QAT), December 2011, at the expense of the organisers. Examiners to be determined.

The above examinations will take place provided there is a sufficient number of candidates.

For 2012 up to the O.G. of London, there will be no refereeing examination.

### **Referee Seminar and Examination, for female candidates only**

Refereeing examination for women only, in Athens, 18, 19, 20 November 2011. In this examination candidates from all continents may participate.
