# FINANCIAL REPORT 2006-7 15 February, 2008

I am pleased to submit for your approval the balance sheet and the profit and loss account for the financial year ending on 30 September, 2007, as well as the proposed budget for the financial year October 1, 2008 to September 30, 2009.

# 1: BALANCE SHEET

#### **ASSETS**

#### Fixed assets

a) Office and computer equipment

The gross value of this equipment shows an increase of **CHF73,970**, of which CHF58,950 relates to modifications to the FIE website.

- b) Office furniture no change to the gross value.
- c) Transportation equipment sale of the FIE car, fully written down.
- d) General equipment no change, fully written down.
- e) Sporting equipment increase in gross value of **CHF100,936**; Scoring equipment for World Championships and Grand Prix.
- f) Other fixed assets no change to the gross value.

**Deposits and guarantees** – no change.

### Circulating assets

- a) Debtor federations. At **CHF 38,634**, a minor increase over 2005-6 (CHF37,649). A provision of CHF19,000 has been made.
- b) Accrued income (*Produits à recevoir*) CHF61,325, which represents repayments, 56% of which had been received by 12 February, 2008.
- c) Other clients suppliers' payments on account, CHF18,855 for advertisements in the Revue, CHF9,205 of which had been received by 12 February, 2008.
- d) Advances to personnel permanent advance on travelling expenses of CHF5,000.

The 'capital and reserves' shown represents the FIE's financial position as of end-September 2006.

The excess of expenditure over income (CHF2,104,368) is the outcome of the profit and loss account and the 'TOTAL' the resultant position at end-September 2007.

- k) Junior/Cadet World Championships at CHF100,675, on budget.
- Senior and Veteran World Championships; CHF 214,719, 53% over budget two world championships (Turin and St Petersburg) fell in the same financial year.
- m) Proficiency courses and courses at Fontainebleau CHF415,500, 22% over budget. This item includes two types of course:
  - Those for fencers selected to train before and participate at Belek (CHF53,595) and St Petersburg (CHF72,545), in total 10% below budget.
  - those at Fontainebleau, Mexico City and Beijing, in total CHF289,360 against a budget of CHF200,000.
- n) Training of fencing masters CHF180,204. Schools involved are shown in the Annual Report of the Executive Committee ('Rapport moral)'.
- o) Equipment aid to federations CHF108,399. Under budget
- p) Belek General Assembly CHF1,913. We thank the Turkish Federation for their help in organising this meeting.
- q) President, Central Office ('Bureau') and Executive CHF300,872. Budget overrun, due to additional Executive meetings and increased Bureau representation at official competitions. Travel accounted for 76% of these costs.
