## LETTRE D'INFORMATION DE LA FIE

Ladies and Gentlemen,

### Decisions of the Executive Committee

The FIE Executive Committee, during its meeting held in Leipzig on November 20-21st, 2003, made the following decisions:

#### **a) 2003-2004 Calendar**

##### Men's Epée

1) The French Fencing Federation proposed that the team competition that was to be held in Poitiers on March 13, 2004 be organised in Paris after the individual competition R. Monal (there will be a yearly rotation between Poitiers and Paris).

The proposal was accepted with the following dates : individual competition in Paris on March 12 and 13, 2004 and team competition in Paris on March 14, 2004.

2) The Canadian Fencing Federation requested that the individual and team competitions to be held in Montreal from March 20 to 22nd, 2004 be organised in Vancouver, due to the number of sponsors obtained by this city, who will host the 2010 winter Olympic Games. The request was accepted and the dates remain unchanged.

##### Women's Epée

1) The Great-Britain Fencing Federation requested that the tournament to be held in Ipswich on February 14 and 15, 2004 be organised in London due to the unavailability of the venue.

The request was accepted for practical reasons and the dates remain unchanged.

The calendar on the FIE Internet web site was modified accordingly.

#### **b) Referees for the team competitions**

When the team competitions listed in the 2003/2004 calendar are preceded or followed by an A-grade individual competition that is not Grand Prix, the referees who were appointed for the team competition will also officiate for the individual competition. Delegations will thus not have to bring referees for the A-grade individual competitions followed or preceded by a team competition.

In return, the organizer of the individual competition will collect an entry fee equal to that of the GP individual competitions : 60 US \$ or 60 Euros or 90 CHF.


**c) Meetings for 2004**
