



Handbook of regulations, schedule and standard programme for the organisation of Team World Cup competitions.

Venues

In order to satisfy the sports and media requirements, the Team World cup events have to take place in two rooms and on 12 pistes organised as follows:

1 room with 4 pistes (1-4) with a neat presentation, terraces for the public and scoring boards with information for the spectators on the progress of the competition. This room is only intended for the matches of direct elimination leading to and including the final.

1 room with 8 pistes (5-12) which are used for the first rounds of direct elimination and then for all the ranking matches.

Schedule and places

If the number of teams entered exceeds 32, the competition must begin one hour earlier in order to reduce the number of teams to 32.

Competition days

The Team World Cup events will be scheduled on Saturdays if they are not connected to an individual World Cup or on Sundays if there is an individual competition – in which case it is obligatory that the individual competition takes place on the Friday and Saturday.
