Weapons: Women's épée, Men's épée, Women's foil, Men's foil, Men's sabre

<u>Programme and schedule of the events:</u> See the programme to follow.

Accreditation:

The participants will have to present the following documents at the time of the accreditation:

Passport, FIE licence 2004, medical certificate (attesting the aptitude of the participant to practise fencing) and discharge of responsibility (signed letter). Categories:

The participants will be divided into 2 groups according to their age appearing on the passport and they can fence only in these categories:

Category A: 50 to 59 years old at September 1st 2004

Category B: 60 years old and more at September 1st 2004

Prizes:

Gold, silver and two bronze medals, as well as diplomas, for each category.

Formula:

Pools of 6 or 7 fencers, bouts of 5 hits of 3 minutes. After the pools direct elimination of 10 hits, 2 rounds of 3 minutes, with one minute break between each round; in sabre 1 minute break after 5 hits. A consolation round is planned for eliminated fencers. If there are less than 10 fencers in a category: single pool.

Entries:

The number of entries per federation is limited to 4 participants per country, age group, and weapon.

Entries must be sent by the national federation of each participant to the Austrian Fencing Federation (email address: fencing@fencing.at) with copy to the FIE, (email address: info@fie.ch) before August 10, 2004, deadline.

An entry fee of € 55 per participant will have to be paid **on the spot in cash**.

Referees:

Participating delegations must be accompanied by the number of A or B category referees with valid FIE-licence 2003/2004, provided for by article 0.88 of the rules:

1-4 fencers = no obligation; 5-9 fencers = 1 referee; 10 or more fencers = 2 referees.

Equipment of fencers:

The personal equipment of the fencers must comply to the FIE rules.

A control of the equipment will take place the day **before** the competition.

FIE Licence:

The participants will have to present their FIE licences 2003/2004 at the time of accreditation.

Travel and stav:

Travelling, accommodation and boarding expenses are the responsibility of the participants. See website of Austrian Fencing Federation: www.fencing.at
