

**Dear President,**

As a follow-up to the meeting of the Executive Committee which took place on 20 February 2015 in Lausanne, please find below and in annex the following information, decisions, and documents:

**J/C World Championships 2015 in Tashkent (UZB)**

Given that there will be no manufacturers of fencing equipment on site, the federations must make sure that the athletes have adequate equipment and the back of the vest displays the name of each athlete as well as the acronym of his or her country.

**2015 Congress and proposals**

The place has not been finalised yet, but the date has been established for 21 November 2015.

Pursuant to Statutes, the final date for submission to the FIE headquarters in Lausanne of the proposals for the 2015 Congress is **20 April 2015**.

Please refer to article 3.1 of the Statutes, which establishes the proposals that can be submitted during the 3rd year following the Olympic year, as well as which are the bodies permitted to submit proposals.

**New FIE Anti-doping Rules**

In order to follow up on the modifications brought to the World anti-doping code, the FIE Anti-doping Rules have been modified and are included in annex.

**Senior World Championships 2015 in Moscow (RUS)**

You will find in annex the schedule of competitions, as well as the nominated officials and referees.

**Identification of manufacturer on the gloves**

Although the Publicity Code does not currently permit the identification of the manufacturer on the glove, we have determined that all the gloves available on the market do include this identification. Given that the Publicity Code allows identification on the other pieces of equipment worn by the athletes, the Executive Committee has decided to authorise this identification, effective immediately.

The size of this identification, which shall be compliant with IOC regulations for the 2016 Olympic Games, will be communicated as soon as the IOC decision is made public.

If the identification of the manufacturer is affixed on the glove with the help of a label (glued or sewn), the latter must be placed on the cuff.

Please remember that the glove is part of the fencer's clothing, and therefore cannot be black (art. m.25 3 d).
