

## Rules of weapon control and equipment procedure.

1. The fencer must provide their weapon and equipment to weapon control room for their team in one submission the day before their individual event.
2. All the equipment must be in good condition and working order complying with FIE regulations.
3. The list of items for control are mentioned in Table 1
4. It is obligatory to put the country logos on both legs of the breeches.
5. The athlete's name and country must be printed in dark blue on the back. The letters should be between 8 and 10 cm high. All the prints must be readable.
- 6 **All the advertising logos must conform with IOC requirements**
- 7 After collecting the equipment it is necessary for the fencer to check the presence of the control markings

### Weapon control will be held every day from 3 of August

8.00 – 13.00 – equipment reception

14.00 – 17.00 – equipment collection

3 August all types of weapon will be accepted for control.

4 August only Women's épée.

5 August After 12.00 the weapon control is closed!

6 August only weapon to be fenced next day.

Attention! Special requirements for control of electric jackets.

It is suggested that fencers are reminded of the appropriate rule so that no further problems occur for the Olympic Games. m.28.6. The conductive jacket must be so made that when it is laid flat there is a straight line between the point of junction of the lines of the groin and the two points corresponding to the tops of the hip bones (ilium). RECOMMENDATIONS FOR THE OLYMPICS Under the suggestion of the President of the SEMI Commission the Control of electric jackets will be carried out. Firstly in the Weapon Control room on the respective electrical parameters and geometric dimensions

Control Mark 1. STAMP (Foil m.26 Sabre m.34)

Control mark 2. STAMP In the CALL ROOM on the fencer wearing the jacket in the presence of a representative of the Referee Commission for the fit on the fencer's body.

Attention!

At the Olympics in the men's competition the use of any chest (upper body) protectors is prohibited

Attention!

At the Olympics will not be a fencing equipment shop. Your equipment must be in excellent condition.

**Attention!**

**The possibility of applying any names or country logos on the equipment at the competitions is not provided.**

### **Mask designs**

Masks may feature national designs, on condition that they are approved by the FIE.

### **Body wires and mask wires**

Rio 2016 will provide 2 pre-controlled body wires and where appropriate 2 pre-controlled mask wires to each of the athletes. This equipment will be given in the weapon control room on the respective competition days.

### **Socks**

Socks will only be checked for complying with the IOC rules regarding the logo of the manufacturer.
